Tour Descriptions for Bridgetown, Barbados

COAST TO COAST SCENIC DRIVE

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_07

This scenic drive was especially designed for guests who want to take in the island's highlights with little or no walking. Discover many scenic island sights, such as the National Heroes Square and the Parliament buildings in Bridgetown. Passing Gun Hill, you'll see the carved stone lion, a landmark dating from 1868. As you drive across the island, you'll pass through peaceful villages, eventually reaching St. John's Church, which offers spectacular views of the east and southeast coasts.

After St. John's Church, continue to the craggy and scenic area on the east coast called Bathsheba, a photographer's paradise. From here, you'll have an incredible panoramic view of the hills, gentle slopes and sweeping bays. The stunning boutique hotel, Atlantis is located in the quaint fishing village of Tent Bay. Dramatic views from here create excellent photo opportunities! On the way back to your ship, you'll pass through Holetown, with its monument commemorating the landing of the first English settlers in 1625.

4X4 ADVENTURE & HARRISON'S CAVE EXPEDITION

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_64

Discover the real Barbados above and below, really! Board a specially designed 4x4 vehicle for a scenic drive as your driver guide takes you to some of the more beautiful places around the island and shares his knowledge of the island with you. Your first stop is Harrison Cave, one of the island's most popular attractions. Board an electric tram for an exciting one mile journey through underground caverns of stalactites, stalagmites and fast flowing streams.

After, re-board your 4x4 vehicle to venture off-road through Joe's River Forest and its towering trees and descend onto the East Coast in Bathsheba for refreshments and breathtaking scenery of the unusual rock formations created by the pounding Atlantic Surf. The experience continues cross country some 1000 feet above sea level before you descend on the west coast home to the famous, Sandy Lane Hotel, before you return to the port. There is a scenic 30-minute bus transfer included either at the start or the end of the tour.

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age. Maximum weight allowed is 275 lbs. Some walking and standing is required. Order of tour may change due to prevailing conditions at the time. Prior to boarding the tram at the caves, there is a walk of about 150 feet. You can access a glass-fronted elevator (3 stories), or walk along a cliff-sided boardwalk with steps and inclines to the valley floor where trams are located. At the Cave Interpretative Centre, a short video will be shown prior to boarding the trams.

4X4 ADVENTURE & GREEN MONKEY ENCOUNTER

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_22

Discover what Barbados has to offer as your convoy of 4x4's explores the Scotland District. Experience wild monkeys in their natural habitat at the wildlife reserve – they're free to roam where they please, eating and playing all around you. Stop for photos in Bathsheba, home of local surfers and the main fishing village in the parish of St. Joseph. The 4x4 vehicle is driven by a guide and seats 11 guests.

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age and weigh no more than 280 lbs. Guests with back or neck problems, heart ailments, or who are pregnant are not permitted. Must be in good physical health and able to lift themselves on and off the vehicle. This tour is not offered on Norwegian Getaway.

ISLAND SPLENDOR

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_76

Step aboard your air-conditioned coach for a scenic drive through the rolling hills of the countryside to Orchid World, which sits on 6 acres of land in the central parish of St. George. A meandering path winds its way between beautiful outcrops of coral, rock gardens, cool shady gullies and ponds. Hummingbirds and the soothing sound of running water add to the natural beauty of the natural terrain.

The orchids themselves are spectacular - thousands are grown in shaded houses and outside on freestanding palisades. Wonderful photo opportunities abound for the professional and amateur photographer.

You'll continue to Farley Hill National Park, the imposing ruins of a once magnificent plantation house are surrounded by gardens, lawns and towering royal palms. Your drive then continues along the scenic west coast, home to many wealthy residents.

Note: Approximate walking distance – 300 feet on cobblestone terrain. Wear comfortable shoes and resort casual clothing.

COPACABANA BEACH DAY

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_58

Board your transportation for a short ride through Bridgetown as you pass by the historic Nelson Statue and the Parliament Buildings which are a masterpiece of Gothic Architecture. Upon arrival to Copacabana Beach

Bar, you'll be given a brief orientation before you set out on the beach, a beach chair and shared umbrella is provided for your comfort as you spend the day relaxing and soaking up the sun on a beautiful white sand beach or go for a swim in the cool Caribbean Sea.

Note: Participants must be at least 3 years of age, in good physical condition and weigh no more than 275 lbs. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. Food and beverages are available for purchase at an additional cost at the Copacabana Beach Bar. Changing rooms and showers available.

BARBADOS BEACH BREAK

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_08

Bask in the sun on a palm-fringed beach in the warm white sand with turquoise waters waiting to be explored! Enjoy a scenic transfer on your air-conditioned transportation through the historic capital of Bridgetown. You'll pass Barbados' Parliament Buildings, the 3rd oldest Parliamentary institution in the Western Hemisphere, Heroes Square, with its historic statue of Lord Nelson, and Independence Square as you make your way to Carlisle Bay, one of best beaches and the only natural harbor in Barbados.

Upon your arrival, you'll be served a complimentary drink and given a brief orientation to the beach and facilities. A beach chair and shared umbrella are provided for your comfort, as well as changing rooms and showers. Play a game of beach volleyball or bring your own snorkel equipment and snorkel the shipwrecks in the sheltered bay. Additional drinks or light snacks are available for purchase. This beach has a spot for everyone - just pack a your towel and sunscreen and you are ready to go!

Note: Changing rooms and showers are available. Wear your swimsuit and bring towel and a dry set of clothing to reboard the coaches.

BARBADOS CONCORDE EXPERIENCE & ISLAND DRIVE

Don't miss this world-class attraction. The Barbados Concorde Experience is one-of-a-kind in the Caribbean and very few places in the entire world can call themselves home to a Concorde. However, thanks to its close links with Barbados during its flight operation, this is exactly where you can find G-BOAE now. A leisurely drive along the lively south coast will bring you to this state-of-the-art facility. Learn about the history of flight and particularly supersonic flight. 'Engineered for Speed', a visual show with sound and light effects, will leave you breathless and feeling that you have just witnessed a spectacular takeoff.

A visit into the interior of this amazing aircraft will give you a chance to experience how passengers felt traveling on it. When exiting you'll land right back in Barbados and now it's time to explore some of the island. Leaving Alpha-Echo you'll enjoy incredible views of the picturesque east coast as you drive through the countryside passing many quaint villages with their friendly locals. Your final stop will be at a local rum shop, where you'll have the opportunity to take in some 'Bajan' culture and enjoy a refreshing drink before departing for the port. Tour might operate in reverse but the content will not change.

BEST OF BARBADOS

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_06

Step aboard your air-conditioned coach for a scenic drive through the countryside to Gun Hill Signal Station. Built in 1818, the signal station was restored and landscaped by the Barbados National Trust and now houses a collection of military memorabilia. An officer at the signal station carved the statue of the lion, out of a single piece of rock in 1868. Enjoy a fantastic view of the island from here.

Continue on to Orchid World, which sits on 6 acres of land in the parish of St. George. A path winds its way between beautiful coral, rock gardens, shady gullies and ponds. The orchids are spectacular - thousands are grown in shaded houses and outside on freestanding palisades. You'll be fascinated by the sight of orchids growing mid-air with their roots completely free of soil. Wonderful photo opportunities abound.

Continue to the Highland Adventure Centre, from here the view of the east coast is breathtaking – you'll also see Mount Hillaby the highest point on the island. Refreshments are available for purchase at the well-stocked bar.

Note: Wear casual clothing, comfortable shoes and bring your camera.

ENGLISH TEA AT SUNBURY PLANTATION

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_17

Step back in time and enjoy English Tea in a Great House full of tradition. Take a scenic drive along the south coast, passing through Oistins, a little fishing village famous for its nightly fish fry, and the Barbados Golf Club, before arriving at the Sunbury Plantation House and Museum. The main house of this once-thriving plantation was built over 300 year ago and is magnificently furnished. The cellar houses the Caribbean's finest collection of antique carriages. Tea will be served in the gardens (weather permitting). Enjoy freshly baked scones served with butter, fresh cream and jam; tuna and cheese finger sandwiches; and chocolate, vanilla or fruitcake, while sipping a freshly brewed cup of tea.

HARRISON'S CAVE & SCENIC DRIVE

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_71

Harrison's Cave, located near the center of the island, is a 30 minute ride from Bridgetown. Regarded as one of the finest caves in the world, this landform is unique to the Caribbean. Leaving the Harbour en route to the cave, look out for the historic Sharon Moravian Church which is unique in style and dates back to 1799, a beautiful structure and a part of Barbados' rich history. Once at Harrison's Cave you'll be welcomed at their visitor centre before you enter into the cave on an electric tram and trailer, which descends slowly into the cavern.

The latest technology has been employed to provide indirect lighting, which enhances the magnificence of the cave scenes. You'll witness thousands of gleaming stalagmites and stalactites as you enter the 150 foot Great Hall and then continue to the Rotunda Room and its stunning formations. There will be stops during your tour for photo taking and the most breathtaking of these may be the thunderous 40 foot waterfall which cascades into a blue green lake making this experience, simply extraordinary! After your tour of the cave you can return to the visitor centre to browse and learn more about Barbados' ecosystem. Afterwards, relax and enjoy the views, or take a walk along the trail. A refreshment will be served before your scenic return drive to the harbour.

SEA TURTLE & SHIPWRECK SNORKEL

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_24

Take a sleek, powerboat or pontoon cat to the snorkel site, home to the endangered hawksbill and green turtles. After snorkeling with the turtles, explore the hidden bays along the west coast as your guide regales you with local folklore. Then, head to the south coast to visit the Berwyn shipwreck in Carlisle Bay. A final stop is made at one of Barbados' most beautiful beaches where you can swim or relax before returning to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age, in good health and must be able to walk and swim unassisted. Maximum weight is 275 lbs. Sea conditions may determine changes to the tour stops. Snorkels, masks and snorkel vests are provided. Snorkel vests must be worn at all times. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

TIAMI FIVE STAR CATAMARAN & TURTLES

Bridgetown, Barbados Tour Code: BGI_15

From the moment you step aboard this sleek catamaran, you'll know that you're in for something special! After being greeted by the friendly and outgoing crew, enjoy fresh baked sweet breads, fruit and juice, tea or coffee. Sail along Barbados' scenic coastline to a secluded bay where you'll have the opportunity to swim with groups of wild sea turtles. At another stop you can opt to swim in the crystal waters, relax on the beach or join the professional instructors for an optional tour of beautiful reefs teeming with tropical fish.

Afterwards, feast on a sumptuous hot and cold buffet lunch featuring tasty local dishes along with cool refreshments from the open bar. Let your cares drift away as you sail along, basking in the sunshine or relaxing in the shade of the comfortable cabin as you enjoy the beautiful scenery.

Note: Participants must be at least 21 years of age, provide a valid ID to consume alcohol, and be in good physical condition. All activities, including snorkeling and the turtle encounter, are subject to sea and weather conditions. Snorkeling equipment and instruction are provided. No alcohol will be served until after snorkeling is completed. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
