Located just minutes from Port Canaveral on Florida's Space Coast, the Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex offers a rare, behind-the-scenes look at one of mankind's most fascinating and remarkable achievements - the space program where history was, and still is, made every day. On your tour into KSC, you'll have the chance to see Space Shuttle Launch Pads from the four-story Observation Gantry and the Apollo/Saturn V Center which offers an inspirational and exhilarating look into mankind's quest for the moon.

There's a lot of activities offered at the Apollo/Saturn V Center, including reliving the historic launch of Apollo 8 at the Firing Room Theater; also, being able to marvel at a monstrous 363-foot Saturn V moon rocket. Pick and choose wisely since you won't have time to see everything. Your options include seeing an IMAX® movie, the interactive Astronaut Encounter program or the Shuttle Launch Experience. Finally, your chance to be an astronaut!

Note: Due to the highly secure status of KSC, anything remotely resembling a weapon, pocketknife, pepper spray, etc. won't be permitted and will be confiscated. ## AIRBOAT ADVENTURE

Be on the lookout for alligators and bald eagles onboard your 15-passenger airboat. Glide through the fresh water marshes and protected wetland hammocks within the heart of Central Florida. Your guide will narrate interesting facts during your ride to Lone Cabbage, an old style Florida fish camp on the banks of the beautiful St. Johns River. Here, you can see a wildlife presentation and you'll get a chance to hold a live alligator. Then, travel at speeds of almost 40 mph into pristine sections of fresh water and into a natural cypress swamp. Your eco-guide boat captain will point out local wildlife such as alligators, eagles and birds. At the end of your tour, a gator snack and refreshments will be provided.

Note: Wildlife sightings are frequent, but not guaranteed during the airboat ride. Alligator sightseeing is guaranteed during the wildlife presentation. A light jacket is recommended. The airboat ride is approximately 30 minutes.

Your certified captain will whisk across the deep and shallow water into the highways of the swamp. Each ride will offer you a unique and exhilarating experience of its own. Come within hands reach of alligators, snakes, osprey and turtles. You'll also have the opportunity to see eagles, hawks, cranes, egrets and herons soaring above. As you race across the water see the picturesque habitats of Florida including pickerel weed and water lilies. Your ride will be narrated using noise canceling voice activated headsets. Be sure to hold on to your hats as you rip across the St. Johns River on this fun filled educational tour. After your airboat ride, board a coach for a short ride to Jungle Adventures Nature Park & Zoo. You can't get any closer to Florida's natural wildlife without living in the swamp. Come and experience live guided wildlife encounters with rare Florida panthers, black bears, gray wolves, white-tailed deer, tropical birds, reptiles and mammals. Take a jungle swamp cruise, be surrounded by alligators, and witness some gator feeding. See how Spanish conquistadors lived in the 16th Century at the replica Spanish fort and go on a live guided exploration of their Native American Indian Village replica. It's where old Florida meets new. Note: Wildlife sightings, while very common, are not guaranteed. ## ZIPLINE ADVENTURE AT GATORLAND

Board your coach for an approximate 1 hour narrative ride to Gatorland while your certified eco-guide provides instructions along with a safety video. Upon arrival, you'll be strapped into a safety harness and escorted to the 1st tower. You'll fly over alligators and crocodiles on this thrilling guided nature and wildlife adventure. This journey will take you along 1,200 feet of high flying, heart pounding adventure from some of the finest zip line towers in the world. Standing over seven stories tall, these amazing towers feature multilevel launch pads with breathtaking views over the wildlife.

You'll soar above the treetop canopy 287 ft. over alligators, crocodiles, a tropical waterfall and a luscious hammock landscape. Once at the last tower, you must walk across a 162ft. swing bridge. Then get ready, get set, go! Twin ziplines launch from a 33 ft. tower and pit flyers against each other with the winner reaching speeds of more than 30 MPH! Groups of 12 will be on the queue for the zipline, so when you are not flying, you'll have the choice to explore on your own thousands of alligators in the breeding marsh or take a swamp walk. Catch a gator feeding, experience an up-close encounter with wildlife or gator wrestling, all 3 shows run every 15 minutes.

Note: Participants must be at least 3 year of age, have a min height of 37 inches and a maximum weight of 275 lbs. Pregnant women are not allowed. Participants must wear closed toe shoes. No dresses or skirts allowed and short shorts are discouraged. All guests are required to sign a release, liability waiver, and consent agreement prior to their launch, minors under the age of 18 must have a liability waiver and consent agreement executed and signed by a parent or natural guardian. Transportation to Gatorland is approximately 45 minutes each way. This is an ACCT Certified Zip Line. Food is available for purchase at the park.

## KAYAKING AT MANATEE COVE

Come see dolphins, manatees, and the diversity of life paired with beautiful scenery. Begin with an easy paddle en route to the kayak launch site. Your tour guide will explain the significance of this endangered backwater estuary. Paddle the mangrove as osprey soar overhead, and cross expansive grass flats. Perhaps see the lagoon's top predator- the dolphin- working the flats. Mangroves and sea grass beds create an environment very conducive to the marine life, which supports the osprey, dolphins and other animals. More than 4,000 animal and plant species such as manatees, stingrays, sea turtles, seahorses, 700 species of fish and 310 species of birds, call the Indian River Lagoon "home". Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Sunscreen and a hat are recommended. Maximum guest's combined weight per kayak is 500 lbs. Participants must be able to get in and out of the kayak on their own. A bottle of water will be given to guests. This tour returns to the pier and will not be available for guests disembarking or with a back to back sailing.

## PONTOON CRUISE ON THE BANANA RIVER

Explore the wildlife on this easy guided and narrated tour. Cruise on your pontoon boat to see herds of manatees, flocks of birds, and playful dolphin on their journey through the Cocoa Beach Thousand Islands. The Thousand Islands are a flood tide delta deposit, formed in the past by a breach in the barrier island by a strong storm surge. This natural occurrence created a maze of narrow trails and canals through the natural mangrove islands and hidden hammocks. The spectacular canals through the Thousand Islands provide shelter to manatee, dolphin and a variety of coastal birds. You'll observe reddish egret, wood stork, brown and white pelican, bald eagle, nesting osprey, great blue herons, and many more. The Cocoa Beach Thousand Islands are a part of the Indian River Lagoon estuary also located on the Banana River. Enjoy a soft drink before heading back to your ship. Note: This tour requires no walking. The pontoon boat has a surround-sound and speaker system. Wildlife sightings are not guaranteed. This tour returns to the pier and will not be available for guests disembarking or with a back to back sailing.

## PORT CANAVERAL HIGHLIGHTS

Learn the history of Port Canaveral. From the pier, head over to the Air Force Space & Missile History Center to learn about where the spirit of space exploration began. The History Center features exhibits highlighting every launch complex on Cape Canaveral Air Force Station. Next, stop at The Canaveral locks, built in 1965. This is the largest navigation lock in Florida that connects Port Canaveral with the Banana River. For the past 30 years, this lock has been used after every shuttle launch to transport the shuttle booster rockets, which fell into the ocean after liftoff, back to Cape Canaveral Air Force Station. The Lock is a magnet for fish and birds and on any given day you will see: Brown Pelican, White Ibis, Snowy Egret, Great Blue Heron, and Wood Stork. Manatees and dolphins may often be spotted. Your last stop will be a visit to a fish house and working dock, where thousands of pounds of seafood are caught each year. Here, is where one of Florida's most known species got its start; the Rock shrimp. Finally, you'll end your tour with a taste and sampling of Canaveral Shrimp. Note: Wear comfortable shoes. A light sweater or jacket is recommended.

Cocoa Beach is the "Surfing Capitol of the World" and was home to the TV series I Dream of Jeannie. Here, you can enjoy the beach or walk to area restaurants, bars and shops. The shuttle will drop you off a few yards from the beach, directly behind the world famous Ron Jon Surf Shop.

From here, you can take an exclusive shuttle to Historic Cocoa Village. Tucked away amidst its tree lined streets, the village is an enchanting experience for the entire family. Historic buildings have been renovated and now hold a multitude of antique shops, art galleries, boutiques and specialty shops.
