RISING SON CATAMARAN SWIM & SNORKEL

Board the Rising Son II for Bermuda's ultimate sailing experience. Lounge in the roomy shaded cockpit, or lie out on one of the huge trampolines. Sip complimentary beverages as you cruise by the old remains of Bermuda fortifications. Chat with the crew about Bermuda's past and present as you cruise toward beautiful and secluded swim sites. These sites are hidden among a chain of islands in Mangrove Bay, one of Bermuda's most remote coastal regions.

The catamaran will anchor in six feet of water, where you may choose to swim up to the nearby beach, kayak or kick around with the crew's snorkel gear. After 1 1/2 hours of playtime, you'll be welcomed back aboard for unlimited complimentary Rum Swizzles. Let the island music get you into the vacation spirit as you head out for another hour of true catamaran sailing.

Note: Participants must weigh no more than 300 lbs., be good swimmers, and in good health. Bring sunscreen, a towel and a hat. This tour is not recommended for infants. Guests should be able to walk short distances without assistance. The location for swimming may vary depending on weather conditions. A full cash bar is available. Gear is included.

Don't miss this rare opportunity to attend an international military music spectacular complete with a fireworks finale that will take place in the historic Keep Yard of the Royal Naval Dockyard, right near your cruise ship. The Bermuda Tattoo will welcome world class performers, including the United States Marine Corps 2nd Air Wing Band, The Waterloo Band of The Rifles from the United Kingdom and Canada's Governor General's Foot Guards.

The Jamaica Defense Force Band will join Bermuda's own Regiment Band and Corps of Drums. Massed Pipes and Drums from round the globe, including the renowned Pipes and Drums of The Black Watch 3rd Battalion of The Royal Regiment of Scotland, will fill the night with their stirring sound! The show, replete with choir, artillery guns and a military competition is a treat for the whole family!

The Bermuda Tattoo is modeled off the original Edinburgh Military Tattoo, and while smaller in size, the performance is no less captivating. This event is only staged in Bermuda periodically to celebrate special occasions and is being held this year to mark the 50th Anniversary of The Bermuda Regiment.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Ticket holders make their own way to the nearby venue on foot, approximately 1/4 mile or less and must bring their entrance tickets. Gates open at 6:30pm and you must be in your seat no later than 7:20pm.

The performance is entirely outside, uncovered. If cooler or damp weather is expected, please dress accordingly. The duration of the show is approximately 1 hour and 50 minutes. The performance takes place the evening of October 22, 2015 only.

SHIPWRECK & CORAL REEF SNORKEL COMBO

Join the crew on your snorkel boat, as your Captain sets course for the wreck of the 'Constellation', a shipwreck made world-famous by the film "The Deep". Three decades later, there is even more beautiful coral and fish surrounding the shipwreck. The wreck lies in only 20 feet of water, but is six miles off the north coast of Bermuda. The views are as breathtaking above the water, as they are below.

After a full snorkel instruction and safety briefing, you'll have approximately 45 minutes to explore the 'Constellation', as well as the nearby wreck of the 'Montana'. The Captain will then sound the horn, and prepare to cruise to your next snorkel location, a beautiful and secluded cluster of the world's most healthy coral reef. You'll have another half hour to venture out and explore the underwater world before making the way back to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, weigh no more than 300 lbs. and in good physical health, with no physical handicaps that prevent walking up or down a dive ladder without assistance. This tour is an open-water snorkel, ideally suited for guests who have snorkel experience. Participants must be at least 21 years of age to consume alcohol. A valid photo I.D. is required. Cash bar available onboard. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel and sunscreen.

BERMUDA TRIANGLE SHIPWRECK SNORKEL

Cruise along Bermuda’s west end shoreline toward an unforgettable snorkeling experience. Bermuda is home to over 200 square miles of the Atlantic’s most northerly fringe reef. Although beautiful, the reef is treacherous and there have been over 300 shipwrecks to prove it. On this trip you’ll visit two of Bermuda’s most famous shipwrecks, the Constellation and the Montana. They are home to an abundance of coral and fish and they are situated on the very edge of the surrounding reef.

The Captain will provide you with an overview on the history on Bermuda and some of its shipwrecks. Upon arrival to the site, you’ll be issued with snorkel equipment and given a safety briefing on how you may best enjoy up to one hour of safe snorkeling. Finally, enjoy complimentary Rum Swizzle and soft drinks on the return trip to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age, weigh no more than 300 lbs, be in good physical condition and comfortable with swimming in water too deep to stand. Persons with back problems or physical disabilities should not participate. This tour is weather dependent and alternate reefs will be used. A cash bar is available. Participants must be at least 21 years of age to consume alcohol. A valid photo I.D. is required. Bring your swimsuit, a towel and sunscreen.

After your power snorkel experience you'll have time to enjoy more snorkeling, or lounge with a complimentary beverage at the secluded calm water beach.

Get an introduction to Bermuda’s marine life with snorkeling and beach time. This shoreline cruise takes you to the pristine Sea Gardens, and the shipwreck of the Vixen, a fantastic habitat for a variety of fish and other marine life. This jet-powered, glass bottom boat allows you to view it all, up close, in safe, dry comfort. Departing the reef, you’ll pause at the nearby sea grass beds, where you may spot a few of the many transient turtles.

Then, you’ll head for one of the many small inlet beaches that line the western side of the, where your shallow draft boat will anchor in just 3 feet of water. Here you may take some of the boats snorkel gear and explore the shoreline, wade ashore and relax in the shallows, or play on the boat’s new slide. Island tunes and a complimentary Rum Swizzle on the return boat cruise complete the perfect family fun day.

Note: Guests must be in good health. For those participants wishing to snorkel they must be able to swim. Bring your camera, sunscreen, swimsuit, towel and cash for the bar. Alternate snorkeling sites are subject to change depending on the weather/sea conditions and will be at the discretion of the boat Captain. The water slide is subject to a 200 lb. weight limit.

Take a look at the island’s landscape from a bird’s eye view on top of one of its highest peaks at St. David’s Head. This historic landmark fort is adorned with canons around its perimeter and adjoins St. David’s Lighthouse, where another spectacular view awaits you from the balcony at the top. Then, travel to Cooper’s Island Nature Reserve, one of the island’s premier snorkeling locations where you’ll have an opportunity to snorkel with tropical fish, see coral reefs or just relax on the beach.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, be physically fit and able to walk on rugged terrain for approximately 1.5 miles. Persons with back problems, limited mobility or any major health issues should not participate. Participants wishing to snorkel must be able to swim in water too deep to stand. We recommend that you wear your swimsuit under t-shirt and shorts and wear socks and sneakers, flip-flops are not allowed. Bring swim shoes, hat, towel, sunscreen, camera and cash.

Cruise along the shoreline to view charming Colonial homes, painted in pastel colors that are steeped in history, as well as exclusive neighborhoods known as "Millionaire's Row". Get a different perspective of our beautiful island by water as some of these areas are not accessible by land with car or bus tours!

Your Captain will point out the homes of the rich and famous, such as Michael Douglas and Catherine Zeta-Jones, playwright Eugene O'Neill and illustrator William Denslow, most famous for his work on the "Wizard of Oz". Also, see where John Lennon spent his last summer in paradise inspiring him to write his final album, Double Fantasy. SCENIC WEST END & SOUTH SHORE HIGHLIGHTS BY TAXI

Join a local taxi driver/guide who will point out the many places you can visit during your stay. Start shipside at the Royal Naval Dockyard, steeped in Maritime history. You'll stop at the Heydon Trust Chapel, a tiny cottage that dates back to 1616, located on 43 acres of rural open space and also at Fort Scaur, built in the 1870s to protect overland routes to the Royal Naval Dockyard. You'll cross over Somerset Bridge, presumed to be the smallest drawbridge ever built.

Another stop will be made for pictures at Gibb's Hill Lighthouse, offering incredible views. Built in 1845, this lighthouse is considered one of the oldest cast-iron lighthouses in the world. Continue on to the scenic South Shore, where you'll have an opportunity to view a famous pink sand beach and the impressive barrier reef. Tour concludes in Hamilton, guests are responsible for their own return transportation to the ship.

Note: Taxi cabs carry a maximum of 6 persons per vehicle. Passenger groups may be combined or split to accommodate maximum of 6 persons per vehicle. Wear comfortable shoes. Admission to Gibb's Hill Lighthouse is not included. Wear soft flat shoes; bring a light jacket, sun glasses and a hat. The majority of shops in Hamilton are closed on Sundays.

Your driver will pick you up shipside and head out through Dockyard into Somerset Village. You'll pass over Somerset Drawbridge, the smallest drawbridge in the world. A photo stop will be made at the Gibbs Hill Lighthouse to enjoy the 360 degree view offered from the base. Continuing on this coastal drive, affords you an even more impressive view of the South Shore pink sand beaches, azure blue waters and the imposing barrier reef that encircles the island.

You'll pass by the Botanical Gardens and drive to St. George's, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The town's history is visible with its narrow winding alleys and cobblestone streets, you'll have 45 minutes to explore or shop in this unique old town. You'll then make your way into the City of Hamilton, the capital of Bermuda and a thriving city center, for a brief rest stop before the return to your ship.

Note: Bus is equipped with a hydraulic lift that can accommodate wheelchairs and motorized scooters. Maximum combined weight including chair is 500 lbs.

Travel around the picturesque Harrington Sound with its beautiful bays and coves. En route you'll view charming pastel-colored homes with distinctive architecture. Highlights include admission to the Bermuda Aquarium, Museum and Zoo where you can see everything from chattering cockatoos to tiny seahorses, over 75 species of fish, pink flamingos and much more.

Also included in your tour is admission to the beautiful limestone crystal caves, where you'll have the rare opportunity to view wondrous formations of stalactites and stalagmites. For those not wishing to journey the 81 steps into the caves, the gardens around this area are beautifully manicured and are a great spot to relax or browse the gift shop.

Note: Tour ends in Hamilton and guests are responsible for the cost to make their way back to the ship on time via public ferry. Following the tour, you are welcome to remain in Hamilton to explore further or shop. Most shops are closed on Sundays.

Due to the renovations in progress at the Aquarium, some exhibits may be closed. On Fridays, Norwegian Breakaway guests will be returned to the ship via bus transfer due to ship's 3pm departure time. Wear comfortable shoes, bring sunscreen and a hat.

SCENIC ST. GEORGE

Meet your guide and small intimate group in the Town of St. George's. Experience an official UNESCO "World Heritage Site" on this fully narrated tour of the islands of St. George and St. David. Drive along narrow, winding back roads of the historic old town of St. George's. Visit Bermuda's oldest fort and explore as you meander through the dark passageways of this grand fortress. Next stop allows you a moment to take in the stunning simplicity of St. Peter's Church, believed to be the oldest Anglican Church in the Western Hemisphere.

In the heart of the Town Square, witness the reenactment of the "Town Ducking", the old English-style of public punishments of "wenches" and "town gossips". On adjacent St. David's island, discover the charm of this unique and enchanting community, once known as the US Air Force Base lands. Absorb the imposing views of the Atlantic Ocean from St. David's Lighthouse significant to marine traffic in the 18th century. Many great photo stops are offered on this tour so bring your camera.

Note: Tour will meet at cruiseship pier and be escorted onto high speed ferries over to island of St. George's. Tour includes roundtrip ferry ticket from ship. Tour is operated in 6-seat minivans. Actual tour portion is

approximately 2 1/2 hours in duration and does not include travel time by ferry to St. George's which is 45 minutes each way. The tour will end in St. George's at approximately 1:15 pm allowing for leisure time before your return by ferry at 3:45 pm (ferry return times are subject to change).

MARQUIS HORSE & CARRIAGE RIDE

This scenic tour will acquaint you with the historic Royal Naval Dockyard and surrounding areas of the island. Your tour route is filled with native vegetation and flowers, all of which will be pointed out and described by your knowledgeable guide.

Note: Maximum weight to participate is 300 pounds. Participants will be required to walk less than 0.5 mile to the carriage area and be able to board the carriage without assistance. Carriage seats will be side facing or forward and rear facing depending on carriage type used. Need to step up 3 steps to board carriage.
