RIVER TUBING SAFARI

Falmouth, Jamaica Tour Code: FMH_12

Today you'll explore one of those eight rivers that the Spanish found – the amazing, untouched White River. Take a step back in time when your adventure begins at the 17th-century landmark, Spanish Bridge. This is a site you can only see on your river tubing expedition. HORSEBACK RIDE & SWIM

Be caressed by the refreshing breeze of the Caribbean Sea as your trail takes you along the charming coastline to Chukka Beach. Your experienced guides will educate you on our rich history, culture, flora and fauna. Enjoy a refreshing drink of water or purchase a drink at the bar whilst your guides unsaddle your mounts and prepare for the amazing bareback ride in the Caribbean Sea. Afterwards, take a shower while the guides re-saddle the horses for the return trip to Chukka Cove. ORIGINAL CANOPY TOUR

Falmouth, Jamaica Tour Code: FMH_23

A winding nature trail – through lush jungle in the heart of the spectacular Cranbrook Flower Forest – leads to the start of this unforgettable Canopy Tour adventure. After instruction from extensively trained guides, you'll take a short nature walk to the first platform nestled on the hillside overlooking the treetops and jungle 'canopy'. You begin your tour by soaring through the trees using an intricate system of harnesses, pulleys and carabineers on horizontal traverses, while gazing at the surrounding jungle until you arrive at the next cliffside platform, 45 feet above the ground. A series of traverses ranging from 105 feet to 660 feet in length will have you swinging through the Laughlands River Gorge, a giant valley carved from the surrounding mountain by ancient waters (a sparkling river still flows through it). From your bird's eye view, you'll survey the flora and fauna of this magnificent landscape, all while listening to the gentle sounds of nature. At different points in the tour, you'll even get a glimpse of the miles-away Caribbean Sea and learn interesting facts about the surrounding tree and plant life from our well-informed guides. After leaving the valley, you really fly, embarking on a series of long throws – with the last traverse being 600 feet long. Here, after removing your equipment, you unwind from your exhilarating adventure with a walk through the flowering trees of Cranbrook before being transferred back to the cruise ship pier via Chukka Cove Farm. Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and no older than 70, and weigh no more than 264 lbs. Anything you take must be carried by you throughout the entire tour, at all times leaving both hands free. This tour is not recommended for guests with heart, neck or back problems, mobility/balance problems, or pregnant women. Tour participation is limited.

BOBSLED JAMAICA & DUNN'S RIVER FALLS

Falmouth, Jamaica Tour Code: FMH_43

Experience the three most popular attractions at Rainforest Bobsled Jamaica and the surreal beauty of Dunn's River Falls with this comprehensive package. First, at Mystic Mountain, a ride on the Rainforest Sky Explorer spirits you over the lush seaside tropical forest canopy, straight up 700 feet to the mountain's peak. Upon disembarking, the first attraction to be noticed (and not to be missed) is the educational pavilion, featuring interactive Jamaican history exhibits. A short walk away is the crown jewel of Rainforest Bobsled Jamaica at Mystic Mountain: the Bobsled Jamaica attraction. This signature ride features a gravity-driven plunge through 3,280 feet of twists and turns on a specially designed sled evoking the glory of the 1988 and 1992 Jamaican Olympic bobsled teams. The track for the bobsled run was laid specifically to avoid disturbing the natural landscape. As such, the trail curves around ancient trees, hugs majestic cliff faces and limestone outcroppings looming over the shoreline, and ushers you through narrow chutes of dense rainforest. You control your own decent with an in-sled handbrake, allowing for either a leisurely tour through the forest or a pulse-quickenning dive to the bottom of the mountain. Once your bobsled slides to a graceful stop, you are slowly raised back through the rainforest to the top of the mountain, completing the entire circuit in about 10 minutes. Again at the peak, the Rainforest Sky Explorer waits to carry you down to the base, gliding this time through the dense canopy, affording you breathtaking views of the virgin forest and the rich biodiversity contained within. Note: Participants must be at least 46 inches tall and not suffer from a previous heart condition, neck or back injuries or be pregnant.

RAINFOREST BOBSLED JAMAICA

Falmouth, Jamaica Tour Code: FMH_42

All rollercoaster enthusiasts and adventure seekers will simply love this thrill ride as you fly down the mountain and through the lush tropical forest on a specially built Jamaican bobsled and raised track. Board your air-conditioned transportation for the short drive to Mystic Mountain. Upon arrival embark the Sky Explorer chairlift for a picturesque 15-minute ride through the tropical canopy to the top station. Prior to boarding the bobsled spend a few minutes discovering the interactive educational displays showcasing Jamaica's history, culture and, of course, the story of Jamaica's original bobsled team that competed in the 1988 and 1992 Winter Olympics. After a safety orientation briefing, board your bobsled for an exhilarating ride down the mountain. You control the speed of your descent with an in-sled handbrake, allowing for either a leisurely ride or a pulse quickening dive to the bottom of the mountain. Once you come to a controlled stop, you and the bobsled are slowly raised back to the top through the forest on an elevated tramway. Spend as

much time as you desire at the top admiring the panoramic views, swimming in the infinity edge pool or enjoying a tasty snack from the restaurant. When you are ready to depart, simply hop a ride on the Sky Explorer back to the bottom where a shuttle will take you back to the ship.
