### DISCOVER CAYMAN

Two of Grand Cayman's most popular activities, visiting the Turtle Farm and literally going to Hell, are included on this cruise tour. Sit back, relax and enjoy the highlights of Grand Cayman. Your tour begins in George Town - this prosperous capital ranks as the fifth-largest financial center in the world - with a guided drive along Seven Mile Beach, briefly stopping along the way to capture once-in-a-lifetime snapshots. Continue on to quaint local neighborhoods on your way to the Gingerbread House, followed by a stop at Hell, a small tourist village known for its unusual inferno rock formations. After a 'hell' of an experience, you'll visit the Turtle Farm, home of the world-famous green sea turtle. On the way back to the pier, you'll make a brief stop at one of Cayman's rum cake outlets.

The Dolphin Encounter experience begins with a brief orientation and then you can enjoy the friendship of your dolphin by receiving a kiss or two. You'll also learn about dolphin behaviors and how Dolphin Cove's trainers use hand signals and positive reinforcement to communicate.

Professional photographers are there to capture your memories of an experience of a lifetime. Before heading back to your ship, relax on a spacious catamaran with shaded areas while you head to Cayman's famous Sand Bar to interact, feed and pet southern stingrays in the wild.

### DOLPHIN SWIM WITH STINGRAY SANDBAR

Take a short drive in air conditioned comfort to Dolphin Cove where you'll begin your journey of discovery. Stroll through a tropical jungle of flourishing trees and plants. Continue your adventure at the touch tank where "Captain Don" will invite you to interact with and learn about the exotic sea creatures, including lobsters, starfish, sea urchins and small fish. The highlight of your stay will be when you see the family of beautiful bottlenose dolphins at play in their natural habitat. You'll begin your Dolphin Swim experience with a brief

orientation, then enter deep water where you'll be introduced to these friendly dolphins. Get ready for an experience of a lifetime! Feel the magical thrill of "riding" the dolphin belly to belly. Get to know the dolphins and even enjoy a kiss or two. Professional Photographers are there to capture your memories and experience of a lifetime.

Next, you'll board a spacious boat with shaded areas for a short ride to Grand Cayman's famous Stingray City Sandbar. Here you'll interact with and feed dozens of Southern Stingrays in the wild. Then return to Dolphin Cove to browse, relax or enjoy shopping for your souvenirs before being transported back to George Town for optional shopping.

Climb aboard your air-conditioned bus and you're off to the Cayman Islands Brewery to see how the only locally brewed beer, Caybrew is made and bottled. See the brewing process from start to finish and of course there'll be time at the end for a free sample! Board your bus and pass through downtown Georgetown on your way to The Rum Cake Factory. You'll pass by several famous landmarks: Fort George, The Legislative Assembly Building, Heroes Square, The Peace Memorial and many of the numerous banks Grand Cayman is famous for.

After sampling Cayman's world famous Rum Cake it's time to take a trip to the brewing facilities of Seven Fathom's Rum to see the unique brewing process of Grand Cayman's first and only Rum distillery. During the guided tour you will see a brief informative video of the history of Cayman rum and culture and of course have a taste of the award winning Seven Fathom's Rum!

Note: Guests are advised to wear comfortable walking shoes, sunscreen and bring their cameras. Moderate walking is involved to fully enjoy all sites. The brewery is 2 stories with steps; no ramps or elevators.

## SUNKEN SHIP SNORKEL & TIKI BEACH

George Town, Grand Cayman Tour Code: GEC\_23

Join us for a fun-filled hour of snorkeling at the EX USS Kittiwake Wreck Site, the Cayman Islands newest shipwreck snorkel site. The snorkel site is in the Kittiwake Marine park, where all guests will receive a

commemorative wrist band of the USS Kittiwake - a 251 ft. submarine rescue vessel, which sunk in 56 feet of water. The Kittiwake sits upright with her top deck only 4 feet from the surface. This wreck is a brand new attraction to Grand Cayman and is expected to be around for at least 50 years, due to her double hull structure and some 1800 tons. It is also a great site to see moray eels, lobsters and sea turtles.

After the snorkel you will be transferred to Tiki Beach where you can enjoy the facilities including lounge chair and welcome rum or fruit punch. Rest rooms, changing rooms and fresh water showers are available for your use. For those who prefer a more active day - kayaks, jet skis, parasailing, snorkel equipment and beach floats are available for rent at the water sports center. A full bar service and a la carte restaurant are also available at additional cost.

Note: Participants under the age of 16 must be supervised by an adult. Tour may run in reverse order.

## TURTLES, TURTLES & MORE TURTLES

George Town, Grand Cayman Tour Code: GEC\_06

Visit the most tangible piece of Caymanian heritage by interacting with marine turtles, learning about the conservation efforts and how the turtle is such an integral part of Caymanian lifestyle. Open since 1968, the historic Cayman Turtle Farm, the only one of its kind in the world, is home to over 8,000 green sea turtles ranging in size from hatchlings to 600 pounds each. Passing through the Reception building, guests are immediately able to see the larger turtles in the impressive Breeding Pond. The exhibit is viewed against a heavily landscaped background of lush vegetation and palm trees. Veering to the right, guests can stop and actually handle young turtles in the easily accessible display tanks; a feature sure to be a big hit with all visitors and an amazing and unique photo opportunity. One can also enjoy the wild of the deep blue Caribbean Sea here in our own back yard at the 1.3 million gallon saltwater Turtle Lagoon. Swim and interact with the yearling turtles then come nose-to-nose with sharks and other exotic fish as you peer through the underwater viewing panel of our Predator Tank. Then relax and enjoy a carefree day in the freshwater Breaker's Lagoon. If you get hungry, the Schooners Bar and Grill is nearby so you can purchase and try mouthwatering local cuisines. For those wanting to take a little of the Cayman Turtle Farm home, stop in and visit our 3,500 square foot Gift Shop "Splash" located in the Reception building featuring Cayman Turtle Farm memorabilia with a range of souvenirs to suit all tastes and budgets.

After a brief orientation, you'll travel caravan style, passing through the hotel district of Seven Mile Beach, drive by the Governor's Mansion and stop at Morgan's Harbor to see the beautiful North Sound. You'll proceed to Barkers

National Park, too see the natural mangroves and enjoy a bit of the off the road experience. You might even see a Blue Cayman Iguana! No trip is complete without a visit to the Rum Cake Factory for a taste of the infamous cake.

After passing the Cayman Island Turtle Farm, you're off to "Hell" to see the natural wonder of the limestone foundation and getting a kick out of sending a post card from "Hell". Back at the Tiki Beach Resort you'll have approximately one and a half hours to enjoy a Barbeque lunch, a swim or snorkel in the azure waters off Seven Mile Beach. Parasailing, Kayaks and Wave Runners are available at an additional cost. Guests will be transported back to the pier via air-conditioned bus.

After a safety briefing and orientation, the Cockatoo's sails are hoisted so sit back and relax as the Cockatoo seems to fly across the waters of the North Sound before arriving at the world famous sandbar location at Stingray City! Enjoy a refreshing swim and snorkel or play with the friendly Southern Stingrays - as filmed by National Geographic and Discovery Channels.

The Crew will take pleasure in introducing you to such characters as 'Ray Charles', 'Martha Ray', 'Sugar Ray'

and a host of the other Southern Ray family. After your visit with the rays, the sails are hoisted and the course charted as the Cockatoo sails across the Caribbean waters to the Yacht Club and your awaiting return transportation back to the cruise ship pier and optional shopping.

You will then be led to the touch tank where "Captain Don" will allow you to interact with and learn about exotic sea creatures, including lobsters, starfish, sea urchins and small fish.

Watch the beautiful family of bottlenose dolphins at play in their natural habitat, the Caribbean Sea. Continue your adventure on board a well-appointed motor cruiser, from Dolphin Cove's pier to the world famous stingray city sandbar. Upon arrival, enjoy standing in 3 to 4 feet of water while swimming, playing and interacting with dozens of wild Atlantic Stingrays. Your guide will be with you to help you get the most of your stingray experience. After your amazing adventure, enjoy a refreshing cruise back to Dolphin Cove, where you can relax and stroll through the gift shop for unique souvenirs. ## SEAWORLD OBSERVATORY SHIPWRECK TOUR

George Town, Grand Cayman Tour Code: GEC\_21

The new Seaworld Observatory is a state-of-the-art semi-submarine developed for comfort and maximum viewing in the shallow reefs. The vessel does not submerge. You descend into the hull of this cruising underwater observatory and sit in air-conditioned comfort five feet below the surface of the water. As you explore you'll see an abundance of marine life through large, clear windows. Seaworld Observatory departs from the dock right by the cruise ship dock in downtown George Town. The first site you visit is a dramatic shipwreck, the Cali, a steel schooner built in 1900. This ship ran aground 100 yards off the coast of Grand Cayman in 1944.

From here, your Captain takes you to Cheeseburger Reef. Be sure to have your cameras ready when our diver enters the water and begins to feed the hundreds of multicolored tropical fish right in front of your window. A knowledgeable marine expert will provide answers to your questions and informational narration on the amazing underwater world around you. Hear more tales of the high seas as on your way to see the wreck of the Balboa. The Balboa a 375 foot freighter was traveling from Cayman to Cuba when she encountered one of the worst hurricanes in the island's history on November 10, 1932. The Seaworld Observatory then brings you back to the dock in the heart of George Town.

Note: Guests must be able to navigate an 11 step ladder into the observatory.

Enjoy a casual BBQ lunch (hamburger, hotdog, chicken, salad bar, rolls, condiments and dessert) served directly on the beach and beneath the palm trees with unlimited local beer, rum punch, fruit punch & sodas. Beach chaise lounge chairs are included with this tropical escape. There are four different beachscapes to choose from, including a naturally shaded beach garden, natural shallow rock pools (which are perfect for children); a snorkel reef located just 40 feet from the beach and a promenade beach that provides panoramic views of the entire length of Seven Mile Beach-ideal for families and guests with limited mobility.
