## Tour Descriptions for Key West, Florida

### KEY WEST BY LAND AND SEA

Key West, Florida Tour Code: EYW\_30

This tour offers you the opportunity to explore Key West by land and by sea. Explore dramatic underwater vistas usually reserved for scuba divers. A wide variety of fish and other marine life await you, as you gaze into the underwater world of Key West. Enjoy a narrated eco-tour aboard The Pride of Key West, Fury's glass bottom boat, which offers a smooth ride on a modern catamaran with a seated sun deck and air-conditioned, enclosed viewing area as well as restrooms and a snack bar.

Then hop aboard The Conch Tour Train, the most popular tour in Key West. Since first opening in 1958, it has entertained over 15 million visitors. The expert "engineers" have been extensively trained to share the legends and lore of this charming tropical paradise with you. On your tour, you'll learn what made Key West the richest city in the United States and hear about the golden days of settlement when it was the farthest frontier. You'll hear about the Great Depression, the hurricane that destroyed Henry Flagler's railroad, the building of U.S. 1 and the arrival of the navy during World War II. Join this tour and relive 400 years of history and, like so many visitors before you, become enchanted by the stories, sights and sounds that are distinctly Key West.

Note: Guests can expect a walking time of 8-10 minutes between the ship and the boat. Wheelchairs, walkers and strollers are permitted to get to and from the boat but are not permitted on board. They may be kept at the booth on the dock. During the train portion, guests may place collapsible devices behind the driver.

### KEY LIME BIKE TOUR

**Key West, Florida Tour Code: EYW\_16**

Experience a guided tour of the colorful history and characters of Key West on beach cruiser bikes without breaking a sweat. After a short 10 minute walk from your ship you'll be briefed and suited with your own bike. On this expedition you'll cruise by some of the best sites Key West has to offer, from Jimmy Buffett's Old House, Margaritaville, Sloppy Joe's and Ernest Hemmingway's house. A quick stop at the famous Key West Cemetery where the final resting place to many of Key West's most colorful characters are. Throughout this journey you'll hear about the history of the 'Conch Republic', Havana Water Skiing Mayors, Ship Wrecking and Pirates. Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, 4 feet tall and be able to pedal at least 10 minutes continuously between each stop. Bikes are 26 inch Beach Cruisers. Tour starts in the center of town.

Become captivated by the charm of one of America's architectural treasures and discover why past residents Audubon, Hemingway, and President Truman fell in love with the island. From bold Spanish explorers and wreckers to the great cigar barons and sponge magnates, you'll relive the age of settlement through the exciting days of the railroad, the Great Depression, World War II, the Cuban Missile Crisis and into the present. Find out about Key West's unique role in the Civil War, and Henry Flagler's dream – and how it came true. Key West's rich maritime past comes alive at the Key West Shipwreck Treasures Museum. There you'll meet master wrecker Asa Tift as he shows you how salvaging helped make Key West the richest city in America. Climb the 120-foot wrecking tower and see the best views of Key West. At the Key West Aquarium you'll meet Key West's underwater residents including sharks, turtles, stingrays and hundreds of tropical and game fish. At the touch tank you'll get a hands-on experience with conchs, starfish and hermit crabs. Note: Seats on the train and trolleys are a fixed-size and some have wheelchair lifts with space to store collapsible wheelchairs. If you are travelling with a

wheelchair, please visit the Shore Excursion Desk on board. The Key West Shipwreck Treasures Museum has several flights of stairs. Due to the historic nature of the building, it is not wheelchair accessible.

## HEMINGWAY HOME & SLOPPY JOE'S TOUR

Key West, Florida Tour Code: EYW\_29

An absolute must-see for everyone who visits Key West is the home of Ernest Hemingway and his "home away from home" Sloppy Joe's Bar. You will be met pier side by your professional guide to begin a leisurely stroll throughout old town Key West. Along the way you will see and learn about the Truman Little White House, Bahama Village, the Straw Market and the Key West Lighthouse. Your guide will transport you to 1930's Key West where Hemingway wrote some of his best work. At the museum your guided tour includes the home and beautiful gardens along with a chance to visit with the current residents - the six toed cats. These famous felines are descendants of Hemingway's original pets. Next, we make our way to Hemingway's favorite haunt - Sloppy Joe's Bar. Here you will tour the historic building, learn of Hemingway's more infamous past, and see some fascinating memorabilia. The tour concludes with the option to return to the cruise ship pier with your guide or enjoy your remaining free time downtown.

## HISTORIC HOMES & GARDENS

Key West, Florida Tour Code: EYW\_22

Discover the quaint architecture Key West on a walking tour and enjoy a cup of tea in a garden setting. You'll be met at the pier by a knowledgeable guide who will share information with you about the colorful island during your walk. Each of these National Register properties have fascinating associations with the rich

history of Key West.

The home of Captain Francis Watlington incorporates the influences of Colonial architecture found in the Caribbean and New England. Enjoy tea in the spacious rear garden. You'll walk past Victorian homes to the Curry Mansion, created by the riches of Florida's first millionaire. A two-block stroll brings you to the Audubon House, filled with unique European furnishings and original Birds of America engravings surrounded by an acre of tropical gardens. The excursion ends here, across the street from your pier, and in the midst of shops and further attractions.

## KEY WEST AQUARIUM & BUTTERFLY GARDENS

Key West, Florida Tour Code: EYW\_12

Get up-close and personal with Key West's underwater residents. The aquarium is Key West's first attraction built in 1935 to promote tourism to the island during the Great Depression. Today it is home to hundreds of different species including rays, sharks, fish and turtles and even a touch tank where children of all ages are encouraged to enjoy a hands-on experience with the Keys' sea life. At the Atlantic Shores exhibit, you'll come face-to-face with a Florida Keys near shore environment filled with tropical and game fish, sea turtles and spiny lobster. Then you're off to the Key West Butterfly and Nature Conservatory. Witness hundreds of free-flying butterflies and exotic colorful birds from around the world that inhabit this glass-enclosed, climate-controlled conservatory. Relax and enjoy a magical, one-of-a-kind experience as you walk among the most beautiful creatures in nature and stroll against a backdrop of lush flowers, trees, orchids and cascading waterfalls. To set the stage before you enter their world, spend time in our leaning center where you can view a 15-minute award-winning film that describes the anatomy, physiology and life cycle of the butterfly. ## Activity Levels

**ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.

**ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.

**ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
