## Tour Descriptions for Kralendijk, Bonaire

### BEST OF BONAIRE

**Kralendijk, Bonaire Tour Code: KRA\_10**

Discover Bonaire's folkloric culture and history while enjoying the many beautiful natural sites of the island. Along the northern scenic coastline, Bonaire's legendary blue waters are a breath-taking scene of rustic landscape packed with huge cacti and Divi Divi trees. Goto Lake, a natural salt water lake and flamingo feeding ground, is one of the most beautiful spots on the island.

Narrow tree lined country lanes lead to an animal drinking well and later, a stunning overview of the Rincon countryside. You'll travel through Rincon Village and hear ancient tales of this village built by Spanish explorers in the 14th century.

At the King's Warehouse & Cultural Park guides will meet you in traditional folkloric dress. Here, you can visit replica houses built by Bonaire's early inhabitants. Join an interactive musical presentation and dance to island rhythms. A variety of souvenirs are available for purchase, including locally produced salt products and handcrafted items.

Back on the bus, enjoy a scenic drive with stunning coastline views of crashing waves and the hillside. The last stop, Seru Largo, offers you a spectacular panoramic view of the island. On a clear day, Klein (Little) Curacao can be seen! Your tour concludes with a beautiful drive along the waterfront and the return to your ship.

### HIGHLIGHTS & CULTURE EXPLORER

**Kralendijk, Bonaire Tour Code: KRA\_01**

Savor the flavors of Bonaire on this tour that showcases both the natural and man-made beauty of the island. After a drive through Kralendijk, you'll travel along the scenic route up the coast for views of the ocean, huge candelabra cacti and mesquite trees. You'll head into the heart of island towards the picturesque Rincon Valley, once home to the Arawak Indians. After explorer Amerigo Vespucci landed here in 1499, they were forced into slavery and taken to plantations in Hispaniola.

Later, slaves were brought here from Africa to work on the ranches and in the salt fields. Enjoy stunning views of the countryside from the Altamira look-out point. As you drive through the village, your guide will point out sites of interest. You'll be able to get a taste of the island with a visit to the popular outdoor venue Rose Inn, where you sample locally produced Cadushy liqueur made out of cactus and lime. Your next stop is at the King's Warehouse with a visit at the Mangazina di Rei Culture Park for a real taste of island history.

Your guide will lead you through the park and you'll learn about the area's history. Finish your visit with a refreshing drink of lime juice and continue your drive along the stunning east coast for views of the ocean and then travel south to the salt flats and mountains. Along the way your guide will explain how salt is produced

today and how it was mined by the slaves in the 19th century. Visit the original slave huts which were used as shelters for the slaves working in the salt pans and see the cone shaped white salt mountains before, heading back to your cruise ship pier.

## ECO POWERED TUK TUK CITY TOUR

Kralendijk, Bonaire Tour Code: KRA\_05

You'll join your Tuk-Tuk at the pier and head through the island's capital of Kralendijk. Originally from Thailand and used as mini taxis, the Bonaire Tuk-Tuks are powered with an emission free and environmentally friendly electric motor. In Kralendijk you'll see the small Fort Orange, built in 1639 to defend Bonaire's main harbor. You'll also see flat saltwater areas where you can often find some of the island's bird life, occasionally with some luck even flamingos.

Your Tuk Tuk will pass by the square and through the streets of the capital taking in the local life. A visit will be made to the island's largest church, before taking the scenic route along the ocean boulevard back to the pier.

Note: Participants must weigh less than 260 lbs.

## BONAIRE 4X4 ADVENTURE

Kralendijk, Bonaire Tour Code: KRA\_02

Discover the beauty of Bonaire on this 4x4 Adventure. You'll be met at the pier by your driver guide, before heading off to the east coast for your off-road adventure. This side of the island offers a more rugged coastline, which you'll discover, when you go off-road. See giant cactus trees and look out for wild donkeys, parrots and iguanas along the way. Afterwards, your journey will take you to Sorobon Beach, before heading back on-road along the south coast.

En route, a photo stop will be made so you can see the old slave huts that housed the workers of the salt mines. You'll then continue to view the snow white salt flat mounds. Here, you may be lucky enough to see some of the island's pink flamingos. Your guide will provide you with some interesting facts on the salt production in the area, before your return drive to the pier. During your tour, a complimentary bottle of water will be offered.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, in good general health and not have any preexisting conditions that could be affected by traveling on bumpy roads. This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant.

If you are looking for an off-road adventure to experience Bonaire's hidden sites, this is the tour for you! Your adventure begins the moment you meet your safari guide and board the Big Foot Unimog. Equipped with 4WD, high ground clearance and a full sun shade, this rugged vehicle is the perfect way to explore off road sites. Along the sprawling desert terrain of the east coast, spectacular giant cacti dot the landscape while ocean waves crash and spray the coastline.

Expertly driven through narrow dirt and mud trails, your safari guide will show you watering holes, flamingos wading through mangroves, goats and donkeys grazing in the countryside, offering you several great photo opportunities! Tranquil shallow waters await you at Sorobon Beach, as well as a refreshing drink. You can also choose to remain longer and spend some time relaxing at the beach, or return directly to the ship. Bring a camera and bring the whole family, they'll love it!

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, be in general good health and have no preexisting neck, back or heart conditions. This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant. Participants who wish to stay longer at Sorobon Beach will be responsible for their own return to the cruise pier.

## CATAMARAN SAILING & SWIM

Kralendijk, Bonaire Tour Code: KRA\_06

Board your 40 foot Catamaran and set sail in the Bonaire Marine Park to discover the coral reef alive with a spectrum of tropical fish while snorkeling.

Your tour begins with a short boat transfer to the landing pier of the "Mushi Mushi," a 40-foot sailing catamaran equipped with a platform and stairs for easy access in and out of the water. Main and front sails of the catamaran will be pulled up and the engine turned off for a quiet sail in the Bonaire Marine Park. If you like, you can get involved in setting the sails along with the crew. Enjoy the easy and comfortable sail on a level deck of the Catamaran, no heeling.

Your Captain will select a swimming and snorkel site. After receiving your snorkeling equipment, a snorkel vest and a briefing, you'll enter the water to explore the coral reef alive with a spectrum of tropical fish. If you prefer, you are free to swim or stay aboard and bask in the warm Caribbean sun. Complimentary beverages are yours to enjoy. After an hour at the snorkel and swim site, you'll set sail for a relaxing cruise back to the pier.

Note: Participants must weigh less than 280 lbs., be good swimmers and in good general health, with no preexisting conditions. This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant.

The Bonaire National Marine Park is well known for its legendary clear waters, abundant, variety of marine life as corals. With complete snorkel gear included, you're sure to get a close-up view of the ocean's colorful inhabitants.

Aboard this spacious 46-foot cruiser built for comfort and fun, the crew will make you feel right at home! The helm area has a full hard-top shade that can seat plenty. Wide stairs lead out to a large deck filled with sun-pads or to the foredeck equipped with deck chairs.

Enjoy champagne service and little bites throughout your cruise. Spread out, relax and enjoy! Complimentary refreshments of beer, soft drinks and Caribbean rum punch are also available. Smooth cruising, crystal clear waters, swimming, sunbathing, snorkeling...it's all there and waiting for you.

The swatch of white sand here is the springboard to some of the best snorkeling waters in the Caribbean. To ensure you make the most of your time among the coral, a guide will show you around.

You'll be led around areas where parrot fish, puffer fish and goat fish sightings are common. Once you've explored beneath the waves, you'll have some time to relax in your beach lounge. It's right in the resort, so you're just footsteps away from a beach bar where you can purchase cold drinks and cocktails.

Note: Participants should be in general good health, be a good swimmer and not have any preexisting conditions. This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant.

## DOUBLE DIP SNORKEL TRIP

Kralendijk, Bonaire Tour Code: KRA\_16

Take in two of Bonaire's best snorkel sites at one of the world's top snorkeling and diving destinations. Enjoy the fun and relaxed atmosphere aboard your snorkel boat, the Sea Cow. Experience two very different snorkel sites on Klein Bonaire, a small uninhabited islet off the west coast. You'll be guided through the special wonders of the protected reef and maybe even spot a turtle!

Aboard the mostly shaded boat, you'll receive your snorkel gear which includes snorkel, mask, fins and snorkel vest. A safety briefing is given as well as snorkeling instructions and you will be assigned a group and a guide. After the snorkeling is done, enjoy a rum punch or soft drink.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and weigh no more than 250 lbs. No participants with heart conditions, asthma, walking disabilities, leg injuries, chest injuries and/or recovering from surgery. No pregnant women over 5 months.

## ECO CRUISE BY RIB AT LAC BAY

Set out by safari truck to Lac Bay National Park an important wetlands site and one of the best-preserved mangrove forests in the Caribbean. From your open safari truck with benches and cushions, you'll have a good view of the picturesque suburbs and the forest in the natural Lac Bay. Your driver will provide a narration about the sites.

After an introduction by a licensed park guide, you'll glide by inflatable RIB, powered by an electric eco motor through the sheltered waters of the mangrove forest. This sheltered mangrove area is a nursery for fish that live in the coral and a nesting area for a variety of birds. Your guide will explain the different types of mangrove trees and point out the flora and fauna.

Enjoy a refreshing dip into the warm waters of the bay and have some free time to explore. You'll continue along the mangroves and with some luck you may see the beautiful pink flamingos. On your way back, you'll proceed to the neighborhood Belnem, along the scenic coastline with views to the ocean and return to your cruise ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age, weigh no more than 240 lbs., be in good general health and have no preexisting neck, back or heart conditions. This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant.

**EAST COAST ATV EXPERIENCE**

Prepare to explore the "wild-side" of Bonaire on this exciting off-road ATV adventure. After a short instruction and safety briefing, you'll leave Kralendijk and head off to the east coast of Bonaire. En route, you'll experience the rugged terrain of the Washikemba Reservoir. Here, keep an eye out for wild donkeys, goats and iguanas.

Enjoy a short stop at the Spelonk Lighthouse, the easternmost point of Bonaire. Your adventure continues to one of Bonaire's many caves, which are home to Bonairean bats. An exploration of the cave will reveal these mysterious insect-eating creatures. The return journey will take you through the area of Bolivia, taking in views of the ocean, before heading back to Kralendijk.

Note: Participants must be at least 18 years of age, have a driver's license and be in general good health and not have any preexisting conditions that could be affected by traveling on bumpy roads. This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant. ATV's have two seats and may be shared with other guests.

## GOTO LAKE BIKING ADVENTURE

Kralendijk, Bonaire Tour Code: KRA\_04

Pedal along 12 miles of unspoiled beauty, exploring Bonaire's wildlife and lush landscape, as well as its first settlement. Your tour begins as you board your transportation for a short drive to the starting location outside town. Here, you'll be equipped with a mountain/tour bike and helmet and receive a briefing. Your professional naturalist guide will escort you north on Bonaire's most scenic paved roads, stopping to chat about Bonaire's flora, fauna, and natural history.

Along the way, you'll witness the blush of the pink flamingos reflected off Goto Lake. Next on your itinerary is Dos Pos, (Two Wells), a drinking well for animals, where you'll stop for complimentary water or soft drinks. After 2.5 hours of cycling, your tour concludes in Rincon with a relaxing drive back to the pier.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, weigh less than 240 lbs, be at least 54 inches in height and should be in excellent health. This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant.

## CLEAR BOTTOM KAYAK

You'll kayak to a beach in the southern part of the Bonaire Marine Park - an exquisite snorkeling location with breathtaking coral and colorful fish.

This day of sun and fun starts as you meet your guide at the pier for the short walk to a lovely beach, for your kayaking eco-adventure. First, you'll take a moment for a safety briefing and paddling instructions for your two person glass-bottom kayak. Your stable, sit-on-top kayak is equipped with a comfortable backrest seat, life vests, a waterproof bag for your personal belongings and, of course, paddles. You'll enjoy Bonaire's Caribbean shore as you kayak over shallow water, filled with colorful sea life.

Keep an eye out for pelicans and turtles! Two guides will accompany you all the way. The bay is always protected from the elements. The float is very easy, but for your safety an inflatable tender accompanies the group. Your destination is a beach in the southern part of the Bonaire Marine Park - an exquisite snorkeling location, excellent for all skill levels. Bonaire has a long history of marine preservation and is world renowned for its snorkeling.

Pull your kayak right onto the sandy beach, and moments later you'll be slipping into the warm water with your snorkel gear and enjoying the breathtaking coral and the many colorful tropical reef fish. All of your snorkel equipment is provided, but if you have brought an underwater camera, this would be a great time to use it! Afterwards, relax on the beach and refresh yourself with some provided bottled water before kayaking back along the scenic route to the pier.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, must be in good general health, be a good swimmer and



have no preexisting conditions. Maximum weight capacity per kayak is 350 lbs. This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant.

## BONAIRE MARINE PARK SCUBA EXPERIENCE ( 2-TANK DIVE)

Kralendijk, Bonaire Tour Code: KRA\_13

Find out for yourself why Bonaire is rated the top Caribbean dive destination by readers of Diving Magazine, for 21 consecutive years. Explore the pristine coral reefs of the Bonaire National Marine Park on this 2-tank certified boat dive featuring 2 dive sites. Your tour begins with a short boat ride to the dive center where you'll participate in an orientation designed to protect the coral reef and you'll receive your SCUBA gear. Dive Bonaire's marine park and prepare to witness some of the healthiest corals in the region, along with turtles, rays, and fish of every imaginable color.

The waters are a constant 82 Fahrenheit and visibility averages 100 feet, but at just 40 feet, the diversity of Bonaire's undersea world is incredible. Glide alongside neon colored wrasse, stoplight parrot fish, trumpet fish and angel fish. Bonaire's reefs have enjoyed protection since 1979 when the world's first National Marine Park was created. It became illegal to collect, break or sell live coral and since then the pristine nature of the island's marine resources has drawn divers from around the world. When your 2-tank dive is complete, you'll cruise back to the dive school for a de-briefing and return to the ship with a wonderful memory of your dive.

Note: Participants must be at least 15 years of age and weigh less than 265 lbs. Completion of a waiver is required. Due to restrictions by the Dive Provider, any SCUBA participants currently taking any medication or with a previous medical condition should bring a note from their primary physician stating that they are medically cleared to participate on a SCUBA excursion. Dive Certification Card and proof of diving at least once within the past 12 months is required.

## DISCOVER SCUBA DIVING

Kralendijk, Bonaire Tour Code: KRA\_14

For 21 consecutive years, Bonaire has taken first place for top shore diving destination in the Caribbean and Atlantic region in SCUBA Diving magazine's Readers' Choice Awards. Enjoy your first SCUBA diving experience in Bonaire's award winning National Marine Park. The easy warm waters, protected reefs, along with an incredible variety of fish, are some of the reasons to treat yourself to this unique diving experience. After meeting on the pier for a briefing, you'll be transported by boat to the PADI Dive School for a course outline, video, demonstration and hands-on practice in the water.

In a small group of maximum 4 participants, you'll learn how to use SCUBA equipment, practice some skills in

shallow water, and do an actual dive, just minutes from the dive school on their house reef. At shallow depths, you'll find huge star coral and intricate leaf, scroll and black coral. See neon colored wrasse, bright stoplight parrot fish, trumpet fish and angel fish. You may also spot eel, shrimp, octopus, snails, lobster and more before returning to the school for a de-briefing and cruise back to the pier. The Discover SCUBA takes you one step further than snorkeling and is offered under the rules and principles of the Professional Association of Dive Instructors (PADI).

Note: Participants must be at least 15 years of age and weigh less than 265 lbs. Completion of a waiver is required. Due to restrictions by the Dive Provider, any SCUBA participants currently taking any medication or with a previous medical condition should bring a note from their primary physician stating that they are medically cleared to participate on a SCUBA excursion.

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
