



Glimpse the future of aviation technology at the **Future of Flight Aviation Center and Boeing factory tour** at Paine Field in Everett. Located 30 miles north of Seattle, the Future of Flight Aviation Center is a cutting-edge facility featuring 28,000 square feet of interactive aviation exhibits.

Spend some time browsing exhibits and gift shop before you see the latest breakthroughs in in-flight entertainment, design your very own aircraft using high-tech aviation software, and upgrade at the Gallery to take an exhilarating ride on an XJ5 Flight Simulator.

Watch a brief movie about Boeing's history in the high-definition Boeing Theater; then, hop on a bus and travel a few short minutes to the Boeing factory. This is where you'll go behind the massive hangar doors to witness the building of the world's largest airplanes. The Boeing factory tour provides a fascinating glimpse into aviation industry, and takes you behind the scenes of one of the Northwest's largest employers.

View the flight line and airplanes in various stages of assembly within the largest building in the world by volume -- a whopping 472 million cubic feet of space.

You may even see Boeing's newest plane -- the 787 Dreamliner -- on the assembly line.

Notes:

For security reasons, purses, backpacks, hand carried items, cameras, cell phones and video cameras are not allowed inside the Boeing plant. Rental storage lockers are available at the Future of Flight or items may be left on the coach. This excursion is available only to guests whose cruise does not begin or end in Seattle. Notes:

Narration is available in English, Mandarin and Japanese. Your tour includes transportation to Seattle-Tacoma Airport. This departs from the Sheraton Hotel (one of the trolley stops) at 12 noon, 2pm or 4pm. Choose your departure depending on your flight time. Your luggage will be waiting for you at SeaTac Airport. You must claim it before checking in for your flight. This tour is available only to guests whose cruise ends in Seattle and with flights departing after 3pm. Discover the fascinating remains of what is hidden beneath historic **Pioneer Square** on the **Underground Tour**—one of Seattle's most popular attractions. You'll venture beneath Seattle's sidewalks and streets, to what once were the main roadways and first-floor storefronts of old downtown. Learn all about the history of Seattle in this highly entertaining **walking tour**.

The starting point of your tour is Doc Maynard's Public House—a restored 1890s saloon—but your adventure truly begins en route, as your guide shares tales of Seattle's intriguing subcultures, peppered with irreverent humor.

Venture underground, exploring three city blocks, to see the original remains of the city consumed in the Great Seattle Fire of 1889. Your unforgettable tour ends in Rogues' Gallery gift shop, where you will find a mix of historic displays and an array of contemporary gifts showcasing Seattle's quirky character. Enjoy an hour of **free time** at the famous and fascinating **Pike Place Market** before heading to **SeaTac Airport**, or back to the ship if you are on a coastal cruise.

Notes:

Minimum age is 7 years. Not suitable for guests with severe claustrophobia and/or mobility limitations. Participants must be able to walk on uneven ground and navigate flights of stairs. Taking the Emerald City Trolley tour in Seattle? Consider adding this option to visit two of Seattle's iconic attractions -- one old and one new.

The amazingly futuristic **Space Needle**, a landmark virtually synonymous with the Emerald City, was built in 1962 and offers splendid 360-degree views of seascapes, mountains, and the downtown area. Immediately adjacent, the **Chihuly Garden & Glass Museum** (2012) invites you to experience glass art that is absolutely unparalleled. The colors, forms, and concepts in the works of Dale Chihuly are breathtakingly beautiful and completely unforgettable, a wonderful taste of Seattle's timeless treasures before your flight home.

Notes:

This tour is an "add on" and must be purchased in conjunction with the Hop-On, Hop-Off Trolley tour. You will save \$7 off the adult walk-up rate and \$3 off the child price. The Space Needle VIP Ticket entitles you to expedited entry to the Space Needle Observation Deck.

Woodinville Wine Country

This small-group visit to the **Woodinville wine country** is designed to showcase the flavor and history of the wines of Washington State. Learn why these wines have won so many awards, including the 'best value of 90 point and above' wines in *Wine Spectator* magazine (Feb, 2014).

Your journey takes you from the Seattle waterfront and across beautiful lake Washington, inland to Woodinville, about 25-30 minutes from Seattle. Along the way you may catch a glimpse of Bill Gates' waterfront mansion on the east side of the lake and, on a clear day, you can see the beautiful Cascade and Olympic mountains off in the distance.

Woodinville is now home to more than 118 wineries. This is impressive considering that up until a few years ago there were only 20 of them. Today's figure is a significant percentage of the more than 800 wineries in the state of Washington. In fact, the state is now the second-largest producer of premium wines in the country.

Here in Woodinville, you will experience some of the little gems well known to the locals, which you may never discover on your own. Visit four or five different tasting rooms representing their respective wineries.
