Notes:

Your pass is good for 24 hours. Available only to guests whose cruise ends in Vancouver. To transfer to Vancouver International Airport, look for the Waterfront Station Stop (#2). In the station, look for the Canada Line. This train will transfer you to the airport in approximately 30

minutes. Please consider this when determining what stops to visit. For international departures, you should check in 120 minutes prior to your flight. For domestic departures, you should check in 90 minutes prior to your flight. Remember you will need time to collect your luggage at the airport at the Ground Transportation desk once through the restricted area. Not recommended for guests with international flights prior to 5pm and domestic flights prior to 4pm. Includes luggage storage and transfer for up to two pieces of luggage (with the ability to store more for an additional fee) and a Canada Line transit pass from downtown Vancouver to Vancouver Airport for the day of your departure. 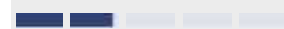

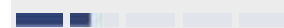

The airport drop-off will be at the Fairmont Hotel Vancouver Airport, which is located within Vancouver Airport. Shuttles to various other airport hotel properties can be accessed from this stop. If you have already purchased an airport transfer with your cruise booking, it will be refunded on board the ship, as this excursion automatically includes a transfer.
