### BARCELONA'S BEST

Barcelona, Spain Tour Code: BCN\_53

Experience Barcelona's diverse architectural heritage. Stroll the narrow streets and handsome squares of the Gothic Quarter, lined with medieval buildings and scattered about with remnants of walls and other constructions from an earlier Roman city. View the magnificent cathedral and the palace of the kings of Aragon.

You'll become well acquainted with Antoni Gaudi, Barcelona's celebrity architect – his unmistakable style with its organic shapes, twisted iron sculptures and colored tiles is hard to miss. Special arrangements have been made at his towering masterpiece, La Sagrada Familia (The Holy Family) Church, so you can visit this treasure without having to stand in a long line. Begun in 1883, it remains unfinished to this day.

Drive along the elegant Passeig de Gracia with its wrought-iron street lamps and fine array of Modernist buildings, including Gaudi's Casa Batllo, with a mosaic façade and undulating roof. You'll wander through the Spanish Village, where you'll find full-scale replicas of the most characteristic buildings from all over Spain, as well as craft workshops, exhibitions of contemporary art and shops offering quality souvenirs. There will be free time in the Gothic Quarter to explore, shop or have lunch on your own.

Note: As tour visits a religious site, please dress appropriately - no bare shoulders, shorts, or skirts above the knee. There is substantial walking on this tour, approximately 3 hours and 20-30 steps. Tour is offered on Norwegian Epic round-trip Rome (Civitavecchia) sailings only.

### SPECTACULAR MONTSERRAT

Barcelona, Spain Tour Code: BCN\_46

You'll head to Montserrat through the main streets of Barcelona, passing the enormous Catalunya Square, the heart of the city known for its fountains and statues. Drive along the elegant Passeig de Gracia with its wrought-iron street lamps and fine array of Modernist buildings, including Gaudi's Casa Mila, with its arches and spiral chimneys.

It is about an hour's drive to Montserrat, an unusual multi-peak mountain topped by pinnacles that look like fingers reaching for the sky offering stunning views of Catalunya. According to legend, villagers discovered a statue of the Madonna in a grotto a millennia ago. And as a result, it became a pilgrimage site, and still draws many of the faithful to venerate the image, which now resides in a grand basilica. Over the centuries the image has darkened by the smoke of millions of candles and she has come to be known as the Black Virgin.

The Benedictine community, now numbering some 80 monks, has served the shrine for almost a thousand years. They are dedicated to a life of prayer, work and welcoming pilgrims. You'll visit the sanctuary, and will have free time to explore on your own, visit the grotto, or take photos of the surrounding landscape. There are souvenir shops available, as well as food outlets.

## SCENIC BARCELONA

Barcelona, Spain Tour Code: BCN\_54

Stroll the narrow streets and handsome squares of the Gothic Quarter, lined with medieval buildings and scattered about with remnants of walls and other constructions from an earlier Roman city. The historic structures include the former palace of the kings of Aragon, and many now contain government administrative offices. Admire the exterior of the stunning cathedral, richly decorated and adorned with gargoyles.

Drive along the elegant Passeig de Gracia with its wrought-iron street lamps and fine array of Modernist buildings, including Gaudi's Casa Mila, with its arches and spiral chimneys. It is known locally as "the stone quarry," because of its wavy facade of rough stone. Originally designed as an apartment building, it now houses a cultural center. Stop for a photo of Gaudi's controversial and towering masterpiece, La Sagrada Familia (The Holy Family) Church. Begun in 1883, it is still unfinished.

A panoramic drive takes you through the memorial Arch of Triumph and Ciutadella Park, home to State of Catalonia's parliament, museums and a monumental fountain designed by a student of Gaudi. You'll also enjoy spectacular views of the harbor and the Olympic Stadium from the top of Montjuic.

## FLAMENCO TASTE

Barcelona, Spain Tour Code: BCN\_89

Drive along the elegant Passeig de Gracia, one of Barcelona's most important shopping and business districts, lined with wrought-iron street lamps and some of the city's most celebrated Modernist architecture. Both the

Passeig and the Rambla radiate out from the enormous Catalunya Square, considered to be the heart of the city. Stop to admire Gaudi's controversial and towering masterpiece, La Sagrada Familia (The Holy Family) Church. Begun in 1883, it is still unfinished.
