BEST OF BERLIN


Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_43

Board your exclusively chartered train for your journey to Berlin. Upon arrival, you'll depart on an exciting tour, covering the top ten highlights of this bustling city. Depart the pier and take a short walk to the train station to your chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey to Berlin. While relaxing and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack. Upon arrival, you'll be met by your local tour guide and transfer to a coach.

Your exciting city tour of Berlin will cover the top ten highlights of the city. Photo stops will be made at the East Side Gallery, a 3/4 mile section of the Berlin wall, Checkpoint Charlie and at the Bebelplatz, one of the most beautiful squares in the city. You'll pass by Potsdamer Platz where the first hole in the Berlin Wall was made and which today is a block of glass and steel skyscrapers. At the Holocaust Memorial, you'll have another opportunity for a photo stop before making your way over to the Brandenburg Gate.

After enjoying a traditional German pub-style lunch at a local restaurant, you'll have an outside visit of Charlottenburg Palace, the oldest surviving Prussian palace. You'll drive into the former western part of Berlin, where you'll pass by the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church and see the Victory Column commemorating the Prussian victories. Depending on the order of the tour and timing, you'll have the opportunity to spend some leisure time, before transferring to the train station for your return journey.

Note: The train is not air-conditioned. The order of sights may vary. Expect heavy traffic and delays on June 27, 2015 due to the Christopher Street Day parade.

PANORAMIC BERLIN & CONCENTRATION CAMP

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_41

Board your exclusively chartered train for your journey to Berlin. You'll visit the former Nazi Concentration Camp at Sachsenhausen and take a panoramic tour of bustling Berlin. Depart the pier and take a short walk to the train station to board your chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey. While relaxing and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack. Upon arrival, you'll be met by your local tour guide and transfer to a coach.

Established in 1936, Sachsenhausen was one of the first concentration camps built by the Nazis. About 6,000 Jews were forcibly brought here after the “Kristallnacht” (Night of Broken Glass), and it was here that some of the first experiments in organized mass murder were made. The scale of the terror remembered here can be very disturbing, however, simply by visiting you can help change the future; as Winston Churchill put it, “the further backward you can look, the further forward you are likely to see.”

An approximately 45 minute scenic drive brings you to Berlin, where you'll enjoy a traditional German – pub style lunch. Your panoramic tour of the German capital will pass by Bebel Platz, one the most beautiful squares in the city, remnants of the Berlin Wall, the former border crossing - Checkpoint Charlie and the Brandenburg Gate. From the comfort of your coach, you'll also see the Berlin Cathedral, the old Jewish quarter and the New Synagogue, Berlin's most prominent Jewish landmark. You'll make a stop at the Holocaust Memorial, a central place of remembrance, before heading to the train station for your return journey.

Note: This tour involves a substantial amount of walking on uneven surface, approximately 2 hours. The camp's museum, archive and library are closed on Mondays, but the open air exhibition and the information center are open. The train is not air-conditioned. The order of sights may vary. Expect heavy traffic and delays on June 27, 2015 due to the Christopher Street Day parade.

PANORAMIC BERLIN & HISTORIC POTSDAM

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_40

Board your exclusively chartered train for Berlin. Discover the extraordinary city of Potsdam and enjoy a panoramic tour of bustling Berlin. Depart the pier and take a short walk to the train station and board your chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey. While relaxing on the train and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack. Upon arrival, you'll be met by your guide and transfer to a coach for a 40 minute ride to Potsdam.

Enjoy a panoramic tour of this city steeped in Prussian royal and imperial history. Pass by the charming Dutch and Russian quarter before you stop at the magnificent summer residence of Frederick the Great, the Palace of Sanssouci. Dating back to the 18th century, it is believed to be one of the most beautiful rococo buildings in Europe. You'll be transferred to a local venue to enjoy a traditional lunch. Stop for a photo of Cecilienhof Palace, constructed in 1915 – it was also the venue for the 1945 Potsdam Conference, attended by Truman, Stalin and Churchill.

Continue to Berlin crossing the Bridge of Glienicke, a popular spy-exchange location during the Cold War. During your panoramic tour you'll stop at a remnant of the Berlin Wall and the famous former border crossing, Check-Point-Charlie. Proceed to the Brandenburg Gate and close by you'll pass the Reichstag government building, the Holocaust Memorial and the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church. You'll circle the Gendarmenmarkt, home to the German and French Cathedrals, before proceeding to the train station for your return journey.

Note: The palace visits are from the outside only. The order of sights may vary. The train is not air-conditioned. Expect heavy traffic and delays on June 27, 2015 due to the Christopher Street Day parade.

BERLIN HIGHLIGHTS & LEISURE TIME

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_44

This tour will introduce you to some of Berlin's major highlights and you'll have free time to explore further on your own. Depart the pier and take a short walk to the train station and board your exclusively chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey to Berlin. While relaxing and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack. Upon arrival, your local tour guide will welcome you and you'll transfer to a coach.

Your sightseeing tour begins with an overview of some of the major highlights of Berlin, you'll pass by remnants of the Berlin Wall, Alexanderplatz Square, Checkpoint Charlie, the Red City Hall, Gendarmenmarkt Square, Potsdam Square, the Victory Column, Bellevue Palace and Brandenburg Gate.

You'll have approximately 3 hours of free time to explore further or perhaps enjoy lunch on your own. Then, meet your escort at the central location point of Gendarmenmarkt square to transfer to the train station for your return journey.

Note: Lunch is not included on this tour. The order of sights may vary. The train is not air-conditioned. Expect heavy traffic and delays on June 27, 2015 due to the Christopher Street Day parade.

BERLIN ON YOUR OWN BY TRAIN

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_45

Are you the type of person who wants to explore a destination entirely on your own? Then don't miss this convenient opportunity for an organized transfer into the heart of Berlin. Depart the pier and take a short walk to the train station and board your exclusively chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey to Berlin. While relaxing and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack.

Upon arrival at one of Berlin's train stations, your escort will accompany you on a short coach transfer to a central drop off point at Gendarmenmarkt square, from where you'll explore Berlin on your own. You'll return to a central train station in the early evening, as your escort has instructed you, for your return train journey.

Note: Your free time in Berlin will vary depending upon arrival and departure times, as well as the train stations used. This tour does not include entrance fees, lunch, guiding services or transportation to the departure train station. Participants are responsible to be at the return train station at the instructed departure time. You'll be provided with details and directions for getting around in Berlin and back to your designated train station, along with emergency contact information. The train is not air-conditioned. Expect heavy traffic and congestion on June 27, 2015 due to the Christopher Street Day parade.

BEST OF ROSTOCK

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_38

This tour covers the top ten sights of the Hanseatic city of Rostock and is the best way to ensure you do not miss the highlights during your visit. Begin with an approximate 30 minute ride into the heart of the city, followed by a panoramic tour of the city by coach before you disembark and cover most of the sights on foot. Step back in time on a city walk through Rostock, Mecklenburg Vorpommern's largest city, passing by the University of Rostock, the oldest and largest university in continental northern Europe, a city gate which survived the ravages of time, the 'New Market' Square lined with six original carefully preserved, gable houses from the 15th and 16th centuries, the Town Hall and St. Mary's Church, an imposing brick Gothic church built in the 13th century.

See the convent of the Holy Cross and the adjacent medieval city wall. View the modern functional buildings (concrete slab structures) built during the 1960s and in contrast the little fishing village Warnemunde, acquired by Rostock's town council in 1323, before returning back to your ship. This tour is a compilation of the best sightseeing attractions Rostock has to offer!

Note: The order of the sights may vary. Inside visit of St. Mary's Church is not part of the tour. You may visit the church on your own leisure time. Most shops in Rostock will be closed on Sundays.

ENCHANTING WISMAR & BREWERY

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_33

Discover Wismar, a medieval, Hanseatic town and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Upon arrival you'll enjoy a guided walk, along cobbled streets with Gothic houses, Baroque buildings and Renaissance facades. The classic

Town Hall, the water tower, the historic drainage system and merchants' houses are just some of the fascinating buildings this town has to offer. Stop for refreshments at a nostalgic brewery dating back to the Middle Ages to taste some medieval beer and enjoy a traditional German snack. You'll return to Warnemunde in the afternoon.

Note: The order of the sights may vary. The drive to Wismar is approximately 75 minutes.

SCHWERIN AND ITS FAIRY-TALE CASTLE

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_34

Depart Warnemünde by coach and transfer directly to the fairy-tale city of Schwerin. Upon arrival, you'll be taken on a guided walk of the Old Town. Your walk will cover the main highlights, such as the historical buildings, the Mecklenburg State Theatre, medieval Schwerin Cathedral, and the imposing Romanesque-Gothic red-brick building. You'll also get to see the magnificent Schwerin Castle, a historic castle located on a picturesque island, considered the capital's most famous building.

Enjoy some time on your own for lunch, maybe a boat ride, depending on the schedule or some shopping. Next, enjoy a guided walk through Schwerin Castle to admire the beautiful interior. The gardens with their majestic beauty offer a stunning view of the castle.

Note: Wear comfortable shoes. This tour is not recommended for guests with walking difficulties.

HIGHLIGHTS OF ROSTOCK & MECKLENBURG

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_30

Depart the pier in the late morning for an approximate 2 1/2 hour scenic coach tour that covers the main attractions within the Warnemuende/Rostock area. Drive to Rostock past the typical Eastern Block living quarters of the area. Upon arrival in Rostock's center, you'll see its century's old red-brick architecture, experience the local Hanseatic ambience, and pass the old 'New Market' with its beautiful City Hall and St. Mary's Church – Rostock's famous landmark.

Continue past ruins of the old city walls and a former STASI prison (State Security of former East Germany) before continuing into the countryside. You'll pass by the Bad Doberan Cathedral, one of northern Germany's largest and mightiest medieval churches that towers above the rest of the village and nearby fields. From here you'll continue through lush countryside and small villages before returning to your ship. This is a perfect tour for

guests with walking difficulties.

Note: The order of the sights may vary. Most shops in Rostock will be closed on Sundays.

ROSTOCK BY TRAM & RIVER CRUISE

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_32

Journey back in time and discover the highlights of the Hanseatic city of Rostock on a guided walk and take a relaxing cruise along the Warnow River. After a short transfer to the station, board an exclusive tram, which is still Rostock's main transportation system and ride into the heart of the city. Your guided walk will take you to one of the oldest universities in Europe - the University of Rostock, founded in 1419 and built in Italian Renaissance style. Continue on a leisurely stroll through and explore the quaint shopping streets, which have flourished since the reunification Germany in 1990.

You'll see the 15th century Town Hall with its 18th century Baroque front structure, and St. Mary's church built around 1398. Enjoy a guided tour of this church before spending some time at your leisure - time permitting. After reuniting with your guide, walk down to the jetty for a relaxing cruise along the Warnow River, transferring you back to Warnemunde. During your approximate 50 minute cruise, you'll be served some typical snacks and refreshing German beer.

Note: The order of sights may vary. Most shops in Rostock are closed on Sundays. The tram is not air-conditioned.

PICTURESQUE VIEWS & THE MOLLI TRAIN

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_31

Travel to Bad Doberan, a former summer residence of the Dukes of Mecklenburg and home to a grand example of Gothic red-brick architecture. Enjoy a visit into the Minster, which was built between 1294 and 1368 and was once a Cistercian convent. It is home to one of Germany's earliest winged altars and also exhibits the earliest wood carved Madonna statue in northern Germany dating back to 1290.

Transfer to a tiny train station and board the Molli, a narrow gauge steam train, for a leisurely 15-20 minute journey to Heiligendamm, passing along Europe's longest Linden tree lined avenue. Board your coach for a brief ride to the seaside resort of Kühlungsborn, where your guide will take you out onto one of the sea bridges. Enjoy some

traditional German cake and a coffee before you stroll through the town center on your own or treat yourself to a short walk along the beach promenade.

Note: The order of sights may vary. The train route may alternate, depending on the day of operation.

DISCOVER WARNEHMÜNDE ON FOOT

Berlin (Warnemunde), Germany Tour Code: WAR_35

Established in 1323, Warnemunde has been a fisherman's village since medieval days. Join your local tour guide for a walking tour of this quaint, little village and visit the regional Heritage Musuem. Meet your guide at the pier for your stroll along the bustling promenades and piers, where mariners either sell their catch or stop during their Baltic journeys. Continue past busy shops and restaurants which adorn the beautiful one-story gabled houses.

A visit to the regional Heritage Museum will present you with interesting exhibits and information about the history and the daily life and work of the fisherman and seafarers. Explore the white-sand beaches where you'll discover the history of the beach basket. Continue your walk to the lighthouse, for an excellent panoramic view. Enjoy some coffee and traditional German cake, before returning to your ship.

Note: There is substantial walking on uneven surfaces and guests have to be able to negotiate some stairs at the museum, which does not have an elevator. This tour is not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Wear comfortable shoes.
