Tour Descriptions for Lisbon, Portugal

EXPLORE THE HEART OF LISBON ON FOOT & GLORIA FUNICULAR

Lisbon, Portugal Tour Code: LIS_57

Explore the oldest, most fascinating part of Lisbon on foot and ride the Gloria Funicular - an iconic symbol of the city. After your visit to the cathedral, follow your guide down to Alfama one of the oldest sections of the city, where your walking tour begins. Discover its cobbled labyrinth of narrow alleys, honeycombed with steps and archways and the houses decorated with wrought iron balconies and panels of tiles.

Spreading out along the right bank of the Tagus, Lisbon is the city of the seven hills. Walking towards the city center, stop in front of the D. Maria Theatre in Rossio Square. Reach the funicular that connects Restauradores Square and the Bairro Alto or High Quarter. The ride takes approximately five minutes and brings you to Sao Pedro de Alcantara Belveder for stunning views of the city. You'll walk down to Chiado, an area with elegant shops and old style cafés and enjoy some free time here.

Note: Tour involves approximately 2 1/2 miles of walking over level and cobblestone terrain with inclines and approximately 60 steps.

ROMANTIC OBIDOS

Lisbon, Portugal Tour Code: LIS_51

Visit the most romantic village in the country, Obidos, a perfectly preserved 13th-century village that for centuries was the love offering of Portuguese kings to their queens. This village enjoys a privileged hilltop setting above a peaceful valley of vineyards.

Enjoy a scenic drive through beautiful countryside to the medieval town of Obidos, dating back to 308 BC. Since the day that King Diniz gave his young bride Isabel of Aragon the town, it has been the wedding gift to all of Portugal's queens. You'll feel as if you are travelling back in time as you enter through its arched gates. Visit the 17th-century Parish Church of Santa Maria, with its magnificent interior decorations in blue and white tiles.

Explore the narrow cobblestone streets at your leisure and feast your eyes on the colorful houses. There are lots of shops to browse in, or you may wish to hike up to the castle, now a hotel or explore the old lookout path on top of the city wall.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking on cobblestone streets with some inclines. Additional walking during free time is at guest's discretion.

MAJESTIC SCENERY & WINE

Lisbon, Portugal Tour Code: LIS_55

Discover beautiful landscapes, small villages and savor the wines that have made Portugal famous. Cross the bridge over the Tagus River towards Sesimbra, a busy fishing village with a fleet of brightly colored boats all moored in the port. High above the town is a Moorish castle.

Travel to the town of Azeitao, best known for its wine, especially the famous Moscatel de Setubal. Here you'll taste the local wines and learn how they are made during your visit to a charming and prestigious wine lodge.

You'll continue towards Arrabida Natural Park which covers a small range of limestone mountains, the road across the top offers remarkable views. The park was established to protect the wild, beautiful landscape and rich variety of birds and wildlife. The name Arrabida derives from Arabic, meaning a place of prayer, and the wooded hillsides are indeed a peaceful retreat.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking on cobblestone and flat surfaces with some steps.

QUELUZ PALACE, SINTRA & CASCAIS

Lisbon, Portugal Tour Code: LIS_24

Discover memorable highlights of Portugal including the Royal Palace at Queluz, Sintra the summer residence of kings and the resort town of Cascais. As you depart Lisbon, enjoy the panorama of the River Tagus with views of the Monument of Discoveries, Jeronimos Monastery and the Tower of Belem. Drive to the Portuguese Royal Palace at Queluz. The simple exterior belies the lavishness within of the Throne Room and the Hall of Ambassadors. The sculpted gardens, with rows of hedges, artistically carved shrubs and huge magnolia trees are impressive.

You'll visit Sintra, considered one of the most beautiful villages in Portugal. The Royal Palace is the dominant architectural feature, located right in the center of town. You'll enjoy some free time here to stroll the charming narrow streets lined with bakeries, craft shops and small boutiques. Continue to the resort town of Cascais, it was developed during the late 19th century around a charming town. Enjoy some free time in the historical center with its narrow cobbled streets and interesting architecture.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking on level ground and cobblestones. Additional walking during free time is at guest's discretion.

SINTRA MOUNTAINS 4X4 ADVENTURE

Lisbon, Portugal Tour Code: LIS_20

Discover the off the beaten path areas of the Sintra Hills which can only be explored by 4x4. Feast your eyes at the endless landscapes dotted with picturesque villages and stop at a wine lodge for a tasting. In the hands of skilled drivers, you'll experience all the thrills of off-road driving, in Sintra's parks and reserves, while enjoying magnificent views. You'll learn something about its back country, convents and country villages, on this fun-filled trip.

Sintra dominates the first part of the route, then head you'll for the heart of the Sintra Hills, with dense foliage, crossing small water courses. Travel to dusty trails, leave the woodlands and head for Alto da Memoria, where you'll see an endless landscape, an immense ocean and the Pena Palace. Continue to the typical country village of Penedo.

In the village of Colares, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy a wine tasting in a regional wine lodge. Stop at Fojo da Adraga, an impressive natural well dug out of the cliffs and watch as powerful waves crash against the bottom. Travel to Europe's most westernmost point - Cabo da Roca.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking on cobblestone streets and sandy terrain with some steps. Tour is not suitable for persons with back problems.

SINTRA & THE ROCKY PEAKS OF PENA

Lisbon, Portugal Tour Code: LIS_50

Combine the beautiful village of Sintra and the mysterious Pena Palace and see important highlights of Lisbon on this full day tour. You'll drive through Sintra's national protected forest area along twisted and narrow roads to a mysterious world. Visit Pena Palace situated in Pena Park, a stretch of rambling woodland, with a scattering of lakes and foliage. The palace was constructed over the ruins of a convent built to celebrate the first sight of Vasco da Gama's returning fleet, chapel and cloister have been retained.

Pena National Palace offers a mix of styles and colors and from its viewpoints you'll have breathtaking views of the city below. Drive to the romantic village of Sintra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The tall conical chimneys of the National Palace and the fabulous Pena Palace, eerily impressive on its peak, are two unmistakable landmarks of this area. Enjoy free time for lunch on your own, explore the narrow cobblestone lanes of this quaint village and browse through the various shops.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking at Pena Palace on inclines and cobblestones, staircases and narrow entrances. Sintra village involves walking on cobblestone streets. This tour is offered on Norwegian Epic October 18th 2015 sailing only.

FATIMA - A PILGRIMAGE SITE

Lisbon, Portugal Tour Code: LIS_60

This is your opportunity to visit Fatima, an important world pilgrimage site, known by many as the Lourdes of Portugal. Your guide will describe the legendary story behind the region's fame en route during your approximately two-hour drive.

Fatima was a very poor and forgotten parish until an apparition of the Virgin Mary was seen by three peasant children back in 1917. The little village was transformed almost overnight into a pilgrimage town that grew around the imposing modern basilica and shrine. You'll stop at the modern basilica and square, which is larger than St. Peter's Square in Vatican City. Here, enjoy about two hours of free time to explore the area on your own.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking over mostly level terrain and some steps. Additional walking during free time is at guest's discretion. As tour visits a religious site, please dress appropriately - no bare shoulders, shorts, or skirts above the knee. Visits may be affected by special ceremonies that may happen without prior notice. This tour is offered on Norwegian Epic October 18th 2015 sailing only.

MONUMENTAL LISBON

Lisbon, Portugal Tour Code: LIS_58

Get acquainted with the highlights of the beautiful city of Lisbon and stop for photos at some of its most iconic landmarks. Drive to the historical Belem quarter by the river Tagus and stop for photos at the Monument of Discoveries and the Tower of Belem. The area is closely linked to the era of discoveries when the Portuguese navigators sailed in search of new lands. Drive to the Jeronimos Monastery and from the outside, admire this impressive building, representative of the Golden Age of the Portuguese Discoveries.

Continue on to Alfama where you'll visit the Lisbon Cathedral -its construction started in 1147 when the city was reconquered from the Moors, by the first king of Portugal. Follow your guide for a walk through this area and immerse yourself in the architecture, sounds and aromas of old Lisbon. It is the oldest and most fascinating area of the city.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1 1/2 miles of walking over level and cobblestone terrain with some inclines and approximately 20 steps. As tour visits a religious site, please dress appropriately - no bare shoulders, shorts or skirts above the knee.

PANORAMIC DRIVE THROUGH LISBON

Lisbon, Portugal Tour Code: LIS_59

A drive through the city introduces you to Lisbon - historical and beautiful, Portugal's capital is full of surprises and you'll see many of the city's main landmarks from your coach. A few photo stops allow you to take home some memorable images.

Drive to the historical Belem quarter by the river Tagus and stop for photos at the Monument of Discoveries and the Tower of Belem., two iconic landmarks of the city. The area is closely linked to the era of discoveries when the Portuguese Navigators sailed in search of new lands.

Drive to the Jerónimos Monastery and from the outside, admire this impressive building, representative of the Golden Age of the Portuguese Discoveries. A scenic drive takes you to Alfama and towards downtown Lisbon, with views of Liberdade Avenue, Restauradores and Comercio Squares and the always busy heart of the city, Rossio Square.

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
