Tour Descriptions for San Juan, Puerto Rico

SAN JUAN CITY TOUR

San Juan, Puerto Rico Tour Code: SJU_21

Enjoy a guided drive through one of the most beautiful cities in the Caribbean with its 17th century architecture and historic buildings. You'll have the opportunity to stroll around the grounds of the biggest fortification built by the Spaniards in the New World on your self guided visit to Fort San Cristobal. Come see its Main Plaza, "Garitas" watchtowers and authentic mortar balls. Re-board your bus and continue your guided tour to the New City, which will take you to the Condado District, filled with high-rise condos and luxury resorts.

A stop is made at one of the beautiful beaches and the Capitol Building for pictures. Return to Old San Juan where you'll visit the famous Plaza Colón. Here you may choose to stay to explore the local surroundings and enjoy some shopping or return to the ship. Take a step back in time and enjoy this captivating journey through history.

Note: We recommend you wear comfortable walking shoes, bring a hat and sunscreen. Due to walking required at the fort, the activity level is substantial. The fort is not wheelchair accessible. There is a steep ramp to access the fort (about 65 paces one way). The first level features the barracks, gun rooms, and video presentation. The next level requires walking up another steep ramp (about 35 paces one way). Accessing the third level observation ports for the best views of the city requires going up another steep ramp (about 65 paces one way). Some of the stops are unguided allowing guests to browse on their own. Traffic in old and new San Juan can be congested. Alternate routes are implemented whenever possible. The stops are unguided allowing guests the leisure to browse on their own. Optional drop off in Old San Juan allows guests to browse, shop and return on their own to the ship.

EVENING SAN JUAN CITY TOUR AND BACARDI

San Juan, Puerto Rico Tour Code: SJU_37

Board your air-conditioned coach for the approximately 25-minute drive to Bacardi located in Cataño. Tour the famous Bacardi Visitor Center which traces the famed rum distillery's history and heritage from the company's founding to the present. Enjoy an approximate 90 minute, guided tour that visits seven exhibit rooms, including a state-of-the-art theater. Your tour concludes with a visit to the Hospitality Pavilion for a complimentary cocktail. Bacardi products are available for purchase. As you leave the town of Cataño, you'll pass the Condado District, a modern area of high-rise condominiums and luxury resorts.

This guided drive will take you to Old San Juan and its 17th century architecture alongside its magnificent historic

buildings. The last stop will bring you to the famous Plaza Colón where you'll have time to take pictures of the San Cristobal Fortress built by the Spaniards between 1634 and 1771 or browse around before returning to the ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 3 years of age and at at least 21 years of age to sample alcoholic beverages. Bacardi is a popular site and extended wait times may be experienced. Bring adequate sun protection and wear comfortable walking shoes. Traffic in Old and New San Juan can be very congested so alternate routes are used whenever possible. The stops are unguided allowing participants to browse on their own.

CUISINE TASTING & HISTORIC WALK

San Juan, Puerto Rico Tour Code: SJU_31

Discover the magic of a "cocina criolla" by spicing up your day with a cooking and dining experience where you'll taste the rich flavors of Puerto Rican cuisine. The meeting point will be the heart of Old San Juan. Here you will be familiarized with important details of Puerto Rico's culture and the mysteries that the cobblestone streets provide. You will also visit the shopping district of Old San Juan, where you can shop for jewelry, marmalades, Puerto Rican coffee, rums, art and so much more.

The highlight of the tour is The Mofongo and Mojito culinary hands on dining experience. You can't come to Puerto Rico and not try the Mofongo at a local restaurant that has a unique colonial atmosphere where you can appreciate the Latin flavors. The staff welcomes you with Puerto Rican hors d'oeuvres and a renowned chef will demonstrate how to create this famous dish. Be a chef for the day and enjoy your delicious creation.

Note: We recommend you wear comfortable walking shoes, bring a hat and sunscreen. Participants must be able to walk over cobblestone streets for approximately 1 1/2 miles.

EL YUNQUE RAINFOREST DRIVE

Don't miss this unique opportunity to visit El Yunque National Rainforest, the only rainforest in the U.S. National Forest System. Come along and enjoy the panoramic view of the tropical woodland with a vast variety of flora and crystalline waterfalls that spread over hills and valleys. You'll stop briefly at one of its waterfalls, the Tourist Visitation Center and the Observation Tower. If weather permits, take a short stroll on a mostly paved pathway in the forest. Choose to visit El Yunque for a once in a lifetime experience to savor tropical nature and its true

beauty! Note: Participants must be at least 3 years of age.

TROPICAL FOREST CANOPY ADVENTURE

San Juan, Puerto Rico Tour Code: SJU_18

Board your air-conditioned transportation for an approximate 30 minute drive to the northern countryside of Puerto Rico where your adventure begins. With the assistance of an experienced system operator, you'll be instructed in the use and wear of the safety equipment. Once you are set, you'll then sail from tree to tree and platform to platform on a network of pulleys and cables mounted between 10 and 70 feet above ground. The adventure consists of 8 horizontal traverses and a rappel which is a fascinating vertical descent. Come along and enjoy the rich diversity of tropical fauna that this venue has to offer while you take part of this exhilarating experience!

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age, minimum height is 46" tall and maximum weight is 250 lbs. We recommend you wear comfortable clothing and closed-toe shoes and that you don't mind getting dirty. This tour is not recommended for women who are pregnant or those with heart trouble, seizure disorders, problems with balance, or back and neck disabilities. All participants on this tour are required to complete a waiver and/or release form. This excursion is for guests that are active, in excellent health and very good physical condition. Tour may require extended periods of physical exertion, extensive walking, climbing and/or hiking. There are numerous steps, inclines, cobblestone and other rough terrain throughout the excursion. Your hands must be free at all times. Safety equipment (harness, gloves and helmet) are provided and must be worn at all times. Air conditioning on the bus could be temporarily discontinued when bus travels up the mountain.

ATV QUAD ADVENTURE – SINGLE

San Juan, Puerto Rico Tour Code: SJU_15

An approximate 45 minute ride will bring you to a beautiful hacienda, located on the eastern country side of Puerto Rico. Upon your arrival, you'll be given operating instructions and a safety briefing which will prepare you for your adventure! Hop aboard an All Terrain Vehicle and follow your guide through the trails, while you enjoy the spectacular scenery. You will roam through towering trees and cross creeks. The guides will stop by the river and if weather permits, you'll have a chance to take a quick dip in the cool waters. Afterwards, you will return to the hacienda where your transportation awaits to bring you back to your ship.

Note: Drivers must be at least 18 years of age, in good health, weigh no more than 260 lbs and provide a valid driver's license. All participants on this tour are required to complete a waiver and/or release form disclosing any

medical conditions. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or guests with back or neck injuries. Wear your swimsuit, closed-toe shoes and bring a towel. ATV's used are Bombardier four track models. Helmet use is mandatory and is provided along with goggles. Swimming in the river is subject to weather and the river's condition.

ATV ADVENTURE

San Juan, Puerto Rico Tour Code: SJU_16

An approximate 45 minute ride will bring you to a beautiful hacienda, located on the eastern countryside of Puerto Rico. Upon your arrival, you'll be given operating instructions and a safety briefing which will prepare you for your adventure!

Hop aboard a two-person All Terrain Vehicle and follow your guide through the trails while you enjoy the spectacular scenery. You'll roam through towering trees and cross creeks. The guides will stop by the river and if weather permits, you'll have a chance to take a quick dip in the cool water. Afterwards, you'll return to the hacienda where your transportation awaits to bring you back to the pier.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. Drivers must be at least 18 years of age, in good health, weigh no more than 260 lbs and provide a valid driver's license. Maximum combined weight is 450 lbs. All participants on this tour are required to complete a waiver and/or release form disclosing any medical conditions. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or guests with back or neck injuries. ATV accommodates two passengers – one driver and one rider. Those wishing to be a passenger/rider on the ATV must be accompanied by a driver and must book on board the ship at the Shore Excursions Desk. Wear your swimsuit, closed-toe shoes and bring a towel. ATV's used are Bombardier four track models. Helmet use is mandatory and is provided along with goggles. Swimming in the river is subject to weather and the river's condition.

HORSEBACK RIDING

San Juan, Puerto Rico Tour Code: SJU_28

Ride your horse on trails that are carefully laid out and wind along the shore of a river on one of Puerto Rico's most famous haciendas. Enjoy the flora and fauna of this lovely area. Horseback riding instruction and an orientation of the rental rules are provided. Guides accompany the group and riders of all levels are welcome.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, 48 inches tall, in good physical condition and weigh no more

than 250 lbs. This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant or those with heart trouble, seizure disorders, problems with balance, or back, shoulder or neck disabilities. Participants should be aware there are inherent risks associated with this activity. Participants are required to complete a waiver and/or release form disclosing any medical conditions. Traffic in this direction can be very congested. Proximity to the water and swimming will be subject to weather conditions. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. Wear comfortable clothing and long pants. Sturdy closed-toe shoes and insect repellent are recommended.

SURFING LESSONS IN PUERTO RICO

Learn how to catch a wave from expert surfers that know their turf. Lessons include how to surf on a safe beach with small waves, learn about the proper equipment, how to stand up on the surfboard, how to stretch, beach etiquette, beach rules between locals, mother nature and lots of fun. EL YUNQUE RAINFOREST HIKE

San Juan, Puerto Rico Tour Code: SJU_29

Drive to El Yunque Rain Forest, the only tropical rain forest in United States' territory, with tropical woodlands of giant ferns, wild orchids and crystalline waterfalls spread over hills and valleys. Your guide will lead you through the wilderness of the El Yunque Rain Forest on a one and a half hour hike.

Note: Participants must be at least 3 years of age and in good physical condition. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. We recommend you wear comfortable shoes and a raincoat. Cameras and other electronics should be kept in waterproof plastic bags.

There are numerous steps, inclines, cobblestones and other rough terrain throughout the hike. Tour requires extended periods of physical exertion, extensive walking, climbing and/or hiking. Trails are narrow and steep; there are no handrails in many places. This tour is not suitable for guests who are pregnant or those with heart trouble, seizure disorders, problems with balance, or back, shoulder or neck disabilities.

Waiver must be signed and medical conditions disclosed. Delays occasionally extend tour duration. Some of the stops are unguided allowing you to browse on your own. Proximity to the water and swimming will be subject to weather conditions. Air-conditioning on the bus may be temporarily discontinued when the bus is traveling up the mountain.

OLD SAN JUAN ON A BICYCLE

San Juan, Puerto Rico Tour Code: SJU_46

Explore San Juan, a 500 year old city with an experienced group of cyclists, just steps from the harbor entrance to see the highlights of San Juan, from the historical capital building "El Capitolio" to a reef sheltered city. Commencing at the dock, tour guides will lead you to the historic capital building for a brief history of the islands largest city.

Ride along the charming cobblestone streets to Christopher Columbus Square and Fort San Cristobal, seeing former battlegrounds from colonial times. Bike through the El Morro landscape to Santa Catalina Palace and Plazoleta de la Rogativa , where you'll stop to learn about the history. After you refuel with a Puerto Rican treat, continue your journey through the other side of the city through Paseo La Princesa (The Princess Path) and Raices (Roots) Fountain. You'll have stops to take photos and your tour concludes back at the pier.

Note: Participants must be at least 13 years of age and weigh no more than 220 lbs. Minimum height is 5" and maximum 6'2". This tour is for active participants who are in excellent health with no disabilities. Pregnant women are not permitted. Total biking distance is approximately 5 miles. Wear comfortable clothing, closed-toes shoes (preferably sneakers), no flip flops, sandals or carry-on bags. You may bring a small bag for a camera. Cameras and cell-phones are not to be used during the ride, only at stops.

Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
