SCENIC ANTIGUA DRIVE

St. John's, Antigua Tour Code: ANU_59

Discover the natural beauty of Antigua and catch glimpses of island life on this scenic drive across the enchanting island. You will board your air conditioned motor coach and begin your drive through the heart of the city as you head out of St. John's. Drive through colorful tranquil villages with charming churches and rolling hills, passing tropical plants and trees along the way. Continuing on to the North Sound region, you will pass the Sir Vivian Richards Cricket Stadium and drive through the villages of All Saints, Liberta and Falmouth. Make a quick stop for refreshments before continuing through the lush green foliage of Fig Tree Drive, the island's most picturesque drive and home of Antigua's tropical forest. Fig is the Antiguan word for banana and you will drive through groves of wild mango, guava, orange, coconut and of course, bananas at every turn. Along this scenic southwest coast to Old Road, Fig Tree Drive climbs up and down hillsides affording breathtaking views. As your island drive takes you back to the ship, you will pass the pineapple fields at Cades Bay and beautiful Darkwood Beach. This island drive will give you a taste of Antigua and will have you wanting to come back for more.

Then, you'll be whisked away to Green Island to relax on the beach or explore the nearby reef. Back on board, the crew will cook a delicious lunch. Next, cruise across English Harbor, to Nelson's Dockyard, one of the most prestigious and renowned dockyards in the world. Finally, journey past the exotic western coast of Antigua where virgin white-sand beaches and pristine bays can still be found. Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age. ANTIGUA CANOPY TOUR

St. John's, Antigua Tour Code: ANU_26

You will be met at your ship and taken to the Antigua rainforest. A welcome drink will be offered. After being briefed by fully trained and experienced guides your exhilarating tour begins. The Antigua Canopy Tour is a unique and award winning eco-tour through Antigua's lush rainforest, where you embark on an unforgettable journey through the verdant forest, high above the trees. Your tour starts at the architectural pleasing Old Pump House with a walk over a suspension bridge from the side of the building, which spans the gorge to the far bank. Once across the bridge, there is a 12 zip lines journey through the forest begins as you trail to the start aerial zips, crisscrossing the gorge. There are zip lines of 52 feet to 328 feet in length. The geography of the gorge dictates that you are above the treetops for large parts of the run – exiting and entering a corridor in the foliage at either end. There are a series of 12 zip lines, 4 aerial walkways, 1 tree house and 2 suspension bridges giving you a wonderful opportunity to have a bird's eye view of the flora and fauna in the rainforest. You will have some short trails into the gorge and then a series of connecting zip lines and bridges, which crisscross the gorge at tree canopy level. The gorge is full of interesting plants and fruits and has a definite "tropical" feel to it especially when you take a break in our tree house, hidden from the rest of the world! Within the gorge there is a series of large trees and certain features; prominent boulders and a rock pool. The gorge offers a shaded area with interesting plants with a range of wild fruits, vines, mosses and lichens. Mineral water is available at several water stations

through the tour. Once back you will be offered a certificate of achievement and time to relax on our verandah with a cool drink or take some time to look at photographs or choose a souvenir from our well stocked gift shop. Note: Participants must be at least 4 feet tall and weigh no more than 265 lbs. Wear closed-toe shoes, shorts or long pants. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or those who are afraid of heights or have health conditions.

KAYAK & SNORKEL ADVENTURE

St. John's, Antigua Tour Code: ANU_10

'Paddle in paradise' with excellent guides on this fantastic adventure for everyone. A 30-minute scenic drive from the port through villages and countryside brings you to beautiful Mercer's Creek overlooking the North Sound

Marine Park and 12 uninhabited islands. Fast motorboats transfer you from the kayak clubhouse to a remote lagoon where, after instruction, guides will lead an approximately 45-minute route through mangroves and tiny islands. Look for shy turtles, skimming ballahoo and starfish in the inlets. Next, reboard your boat for an exhilarating approximately 20-minute ride to an uninhabited island, the habitat of small wildlife and birds. Take an eight-minute guided nature walk to the top and be rewarded with stunning vistas of the 20 acre 'jewel in the ocean'. Bring your camera! After the short descent to the beach, relax under a coconut tree, explore the island or soak in the crystal shallows off the beach. Keen snorkelers can reboard the motorboat and head to an offshore reef; guides will assist with gear and show the best spot to seek amazing marine life. Heading back to the clubhouse by boat, discover more islands and lovely coastline along the way. Look out for endangered ducks near Guiana Island as you skim through the 'Narrows'. The clubhouse is a charming fisherman's cottage featuring Caribbean art, artifacts, tropical birds and exotic plants. Here you'll be treated to chilled aromatherapy face towels, warm hospitality and delicious refreshments, before returning to your ship. This is an eco adventure not to be missed! Note: Participants must be at least 7 years of age and know how to swim. Maximum combined weight per kayak is 400 lbs. Kayaks are for two people. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or those with back or neck injuries, respiratory or heart conditions, or walking difficulties. We recommend you wear your swimsuit, and bring a towel, water shoes and sunscreen.

NELSON'S DOCKYARD & ISLAND DRIVE

Take a short, informative walking tour through the dockyard with its restored buildings. You'll also have free time to explore the museum, art gallery, gift shop, and boutiques. Enjoy a complimentary beverage before continuing on to Blockhouse Ruins. View the remains of the powder magazine, gun platforms, cisterns and officer's barracks atop this sheer cliff. Your final stop is Fort Lookout overlooking English Harbor and Nelson's Dockyard. Note: Participants must be at least 3 years of age. We recommend you wear comfortable walking shoes. Order of tour may vary.

STINGRAY SWIM & SNORKEL

You'll be greeted by the staff at the Stingray City dive shop and given a safety briefing before a fun interaction with the rays. Protected by the fringing reef, the calm crystal-clear waters are home to many southern stingrays. You'll be assisted and supervised by the qualified staff into the stingray habitat where you'll be able to play with, pet, and perhaps even feed the stingrays. Entry into the 3-8-foot deep water is an easy step from the large swim

platform. Even non-swimmers can enjoy the rays. These amazing animals will surprise you with their gentleness and with the informative briefing you receive, these once-feared 'beasts' will find a special new place in your heart and provide you with an unforgettable memory. Note: The dive shop has a changing room, restroom, and locker facilities for your convenience. All snorkel equipment is provided. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
