## Tour Descriptions for Stockholm, Sweden

### BEST OF STOCKHOLM

Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_52

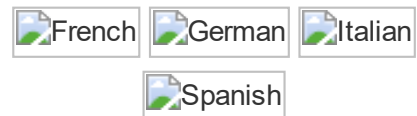
Meet your guide and start your tour with a short panoramic drive of Stockholm. Continue to the imposing City Hall, renowned for its architecture, murals and which is the site of the Nobel Prize Banquet. Completed in 1923, this building is the result of a 12 year effort by artists and craftsmen. Pass through the city center to the neighboring Island of Djurgarden, regarded as Stockholm's outdoor recreation center, with Grona Lund Tivoli, Skansen Open-Air Museum and extensive park lands beyond.

While on the island, visit the museum of the Swedish warship 'Vasa', once considered one of the world's largest and the pride of Sweden's mighty navy. The present museum is built around the 17th century warship which sank in Stockholm's inner harbor on her maiden voyage in 1628. Its discovery in 1956 and subsequent salvage in 1961 is one of the most important events in marine archaeology. Painstakingly restored to much of its original magnificence, 'Vasa' represents an authentic piece of living history. You'll also pass by the Old Town before returning to the pier.

Note: City Hall may close with short notice due to special events.

### BEAUTIFUL STOCKHOLM & VASA

Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_51

Meet your guide and begin with a short panoramic drive of the city. Continue to Gamla Stan, the enchanting, medieval Old Town. You'll pass the Royal Palace and the dramatic royal theater as you drive to the island of Djurgarden, home of the Vasa Museum. In the Vasa Museum, you'll see the Swedish warship 'Vasa', once considered the pride of Sweden's navy. The present museum is built around the restored 17th century warship, which sank in Stockholm's inner harbor on her maiden voyage in 1628.

It was salvaged in 1961 with more than 12,000 objects on board and is one of the most important events in marine archaeology. Continue on your tour to Ostermalm, a fashionable neighborhood of stately apartment buildings, then on to Sergel's Torg, a square that is the focal point of modern Stockholm. Proceed south past the Parliament Building and the House of Nobility before returning to the pier.

## ICE BAR, OLD TOWN & VASA

**Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_60**

Visit Stockholm's oldest and coziest quarter, the old town of Gamla Stan. Witness the historic elegance of the exterior of the dominating Royal Palace, and travel through the narrow, twisting alleys and cobblestone streets. You'll also see Stortorget and the Great Square, the hub of the Old Town, dominated by the old Stock Exchange, today housing the Nobel Museum and the Swedish Academy. Rejoin your coach and continue through the city center and on to the Nordic Hotel in the heart of the city, where the world's first permanent ice bar is located. The interior is kept at -5° Centigrade all year round. The whole interior, including glasses, is made of pure, clear ice from the Torne River in Northern Sweden.

A complimentary drink in an ice glass will be served and the staff will tell you more about the bar and its construction. After a tasty drink, you'll drive to Djurgarden, a favorite getaway spot for Stockholm residents. In the Vasa Museum, you'll see the Swedish warship 'Vasa', once considered the pride of Sweden's navy. The present museum is built around the restored 17th century warship, which sank in Stockholm's inner harbor on her maiden voyage in 1628. Its salvage in 1961, with more than 12,000 objects on board, is one of the most important events in marine archaeology.

Note: You'll spend approximately 25 minutes in the ice bar. Depending on the licensing laws, non-alcoholic drinks will be served if the bar is unable to offer vodka. Tour sequence may vary in order to avoid congestion at the venues. There are cobblestone streets in the Old Town. You'll have some free time for lunch on your own in the Old Town or City Centre.

**Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_77**

Hop aboard an open top tour bus and explore Stockholm and its sights at your own pace. ## ICE BAR & OLD TOWN

Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_54

Visit Stockholm's oldest and coziest quarter, the Old Town of Gamla Stan. Witness the historic elegance of the exterior of the dominating Royal Palace, and stroll along the narrow, twisting alleys and cobblestone streets. You'll experience the medieval intimacy of what is today a living historical monument of international renown. You'll also see Stortorget and the Great Square, the hub of the Old Town, dominated by the old Stock Exchange, today housing the Nobel Museum and the Swedish Academy.

Rejoin your coach and continue through the city center and on to the Nordic Hotel in the heart of the city, where the world's first permanent ice bar is located. The interior is kept at -5° Centigrade year round. The whole interior, including glasses, is made of pure, clear ice from the Torne River in Northern Sweden. A complimentary drink in an ice glass will be served and the staff will tell you more about the bar and its construction.

Note: You'll spend approximately 25 minutes in the ice bar. Depending on the licensing laws, non-alcoholic drinks will be served if the bar is unable to offer vodka, which might depend on the time of the day (no alcohol allowed before 11:00AM). Tour sequence may vary in order to avoid congestion at the venues.

## STOCKHOLM & ROOF TOP WALK

Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_76

Try something sensational and unique while visiting Stockholm; a guided walk conducted along a roof top of Riddarholmen, the small neighboring island of the Old Town. Buckle up in your safety harness and take your first steps along the narrow rooftop path that you'll follow. You'll be stunned by the breathtaking views and the stories that your guide will narrate. Continue with a walking tour to the Old Town of Gamla Stan, the oldest and coziest quarter of Stockholm.

Witness the historic elegance of the exterior of the dominating Royal Palace combined with a stroll along the narrow streets, past a wide variety of shops and boutiques. After the tour, enjoy some free time on your own in Old Town. Rejoin your coach and enjoy panoramic sightseeing of Stockholm passing the Parliament Building, the Royal Opera, the city Center with Sergels Torg, the Concert Hall and more.

Note: Participants under 15 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Guest must weigh less than 265 lbs. and be at least 5 feet tall. If you have a fear of heights, have cardiovascular problems or have a tendency to faint, this tour is not for you.

## STOCKHOLM BY LAND & SEA

Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_57

See Stockholm by land and sea. Begin with a panoramic tour of the city, as well as the enchanting medieval Old Town, with the Royal Palace overlooking Stockholm's inner harbour. The island of Riddarholmen, connected with the Old Town by a bridge is dominated by the 13th century church, best known as a place for royal burials. Continue past the Royal Opera House and through the modern shopping and business areas at Hamngatan and Sergels Torg.

Next, board your sightseeing vessel for a 'Royal Canal' tour taking you into the Eco Park, Stockholm's National City Park. Cruise along Strandvagen, one of the most exclusive areas in Stockholm. Also, see the green and lush park areas of Djurgarden. Here, you'll find the Gröna Lund Tivoli, the Skansen Open-Air Museum, and the well-known Vasa Museum; housing the 17th century warship Vasa. Pass by Fjäderholmarna, the Feather Islands, before returning to the central part of town.

## STOCKHOLM HIGHLIGHTS

Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_55

Travel through the city districts of Norrmalm, Östermalm, and Djurgården. Pass the enchanting medieval Old Town, "Gamla Stan" with the Royal Palace overlooking Stockholm's inner harbor. From the historic Island of Riddarholmen, adjacent to the Old Town, you'll have a stunning view over lake Mälaren and the City Hall. Proceed past the Royal Dramatic Theatre along Strandvägen to the island of Djurgården. The island is home to Stockholm's amusement and recreation centers, great parks, beautiful gardens, cafés and restaurants.

Here, you'll also find the Gröna Lund Tivoli, the Skansen Open Air Museum and the well-known Vasa Museum, housing the 17th century warship Vasa. Continue through the Diplomat quarters and through Östermalm, a fashionable neighborhood of stately apartment buildings. On the island of Kungsholmen, you'll pass the impressive City Hall, renowned for its architecture and site of the annual Nobel Prize before returning to your ship.

## STOCKHOLM & SIGTUNA

Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_74

Drive through the central parts of Stockholm, view the dominating Royal Palace, the Parliament building, the Opera and more. Continue to the nearby island of Djurgarden, where the number one attraction in Stockholm is located - the Vasa Museum. Visit the museum, housing the warship Vasa, once the pride of Sweden's mighty navy. On her maiden voyage in 1628 she capsized and sank in Stockholm's inner harbor. In 1961, after 333 years at the bottom of the sea she was salvaged and is today restored to much of her original magnificence.

Continue through the northern outskirts of the city and through the scenic countryside en route to Sigtuna, an idyllic little town, an approximate 45 minute drive north of Stockholm. Sigtuna was founded around 980 AD on the threshold of a new age as the Viking period became the medieval period. Sigtuna became the first Christian town in Sweden, a centre of the new religion. In the 13th century, Dominican friars built the first brick church, St Mary's. Since the 16th century, it has been the parish church. Enjoy some free time before returning to Stockholm and the pier.

Note: There are cobblestone streets in Sigtuna.

## SCENIC STOCKHOLM, SKYVIEW & VASA

Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_65

Be one with the sky as you ride one of the most remarkable attractions in Sweden, the SkyView. The Ericsson Globe Arena, resembling a giant golf ball, is the largest spherical building in the world. An exhilarating ride will take you to the top of the Globe. At 426 feet (130 meters) above sea level, the glass gondola will stop for you to have ample time to marvel over the magnificent view over the city.

Continue your introduction tour of Stockholm on the ground with a panoramic drive covering all major sights before stopping at the Vasa Museum, home to the magnificent warship 'Vasa'. The 'Vasa' dates back to the 17th century and is the best preserved warship of its time. Afterwards you'll be able to enjoy some free time in the city for lunch on your own or other activities before returning to your ship.

## ABBA THE MUSEUM & CITY HIGHLIGHTS

Stockholm, Sweden Tour Code: STO\_15

In 2013, ABBA the museum opened its doors as a part of the new Swedish Music Hall of Fame. ABBA remains Sweden’s most successful band of all time, with sales of 378 million albums around the world. The Museum spans the band’s career all the way from the start in 1970, via the breakthrough with ‘Waterloo’ in 1974, the grand world tours and finally, the split in 1983. Since then, ABBA has lived on through a wide range of musical projects run by Björn Ulvaeus and Benny Andersson, whose musical ‘Mamma Mia!’ revived the public’s interest in ABBA’s music, yet again.

The museum will give you an overall picture of the band, the music and the unlikely success they experienced in the 70’s and 80’s. You’ll enter an interactive music documentary that invites you backstage, as well as on and in front of it. Next, view City Hall where Benny performed for the very first time. The tour continues passed the Royal Opera, the scene of ABBA’s legendary 1976 royal wedding gala performance. Benny and Anni-Frid at one time lived in the Old Town. Driving through the city areas and passing most of the main sights, you’ll not miss out on the city highlights!

Note: You'll spend approximately 90 minutes inside the museum.
