THE BEST OF MAZATLAN

Mazatlan, Mexico Tour Code: MZT_09

Your tour begins with an interesting ride along Mazatlan's oceanfront for a view of the lighthouse and offshore islands. Continue into the heart of the old downtown for a short visit to the imposing cathedral before a stop at a waterfront rocky promontory to view the brave cliff divers. You'll have time to browse or shop at the Golden Zone before heading for a resort for an afternoon of swimming, sunning and relaxing, where you'll also enjoy a delightful lunch. Your escort will provide you with towels, a place to change and show you where lunch will be served. The return to your ship will be by taxi in groups of four.

Note: We recommend that you bring your swimsuit, beach gear and leave your valuables on board the ship.

HIKE TO THE LIGHTHOUSE

Mazatlan, Mexico Tour Code: MZT 15

If you would like to get the best view of all of Mazatlan, you'll find it at this magnificent lighthouse, 515-feet (157 m) above sea level. This is the highest natural working lighthouse in the world and at night, light can be seen more than 30 miles out at sea. Your invigorating day starts when you board your transport for a five minute ride to the foot of El Creston hill, where the lighthouse is located. Soon after, your challenging hike will take you up the winding path to the world's highest natural lighthouse.

If you're a nature lover, don't miss this opportunity to see iguanas, tropical birds, butterflies and some exotic varieties of cactus and flowers along the way. Arriving at the top, your reward is the stunning view, which includes the Pacific Ocean, your ship by the harbor below and miles of Mexican coastline to the south and north. You'll have 25 minutes to relax, have a drink and take photos. Pass by the Historical Center before on the way back to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age. Pregnant women, those with a heart condition or with back or knee problems cannot participate. Hike is on uneven gravel terrain with inclines for approximately 1 1/2 miles and one hour in duration.

OLD MAZATLAN WALKING TOUR

Mazatlan, Mexico Tour Code: MZT_07

Your journey starts with a short taxi ride to the Continuity of Life Monument, where your walking tour begins. First, make your way to a rocky promontory to watch the local cliff divers. You'll learn about several monuments as you

continue through Old Mazatlan, past the Military Hospital and Bank of Mexico building which is surrounded by old houses. Continue into the heart of the old downtown, where you'll find the historical center of Mazatlan, while your guide informs you about the area's history.

Visit the House of Music, a museum, old houses and the magnificent and recently restored to its original European-style Angela Peralta Theater, named in honor of the world famous Mexican opera singer. Complimentary refreshments will be served before proceeding with your walking tour through the narrow streets, arriving at the city's main square. Here you'll find City Hall, the post office building, the cathedral (dating back from 1875) and the city market where your walking tour ends. You have the option to return directly to your ship or be dropped at the Golden Zone for some shopping. If you decide to go to the Golden Zone, it will be your responsibility to get back to your ship on time.

Note: Wear comfortable walking shoes. Sidewalks can be uneven in many areas. Total walking distance is approximately one mile at a steady pace on paved surfaces, with some steps. All sights are within a 5 to 10-minute walking radius. Pregnant women and those with a heart condition, knee or back problems should not participate.

HISTORIC MAZATLAN BY RHINO

Mazatlan, Mexico Tour Code: MZT_42

Discover beautiful Mazatlan in a two passenger mini-Rhino. See various sites that most tourists never get to see. This is a perfect vehicle to drive through the narrow streets of the Historic District. Before starting your tour, you'll receive a brief orientation and safety instructions from your guide. Start by visiting the Cathedral, Machado Plaza which is considered to be the heart of the historic district as well as the Opera House and its museum. Next, stop at the Diver's site for an amazing cliff diver's show; continue driving north along the ocean front boulevard towards New Mazatlán. Here, enjoy the scenery and views of 'Puerto Viejo Bay', beaches and islands. Upon arrival to the Rhino's base camp in the Golden Zone, you'll have time for some shopping before returning to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and weigh no more than 250 lbs. Drivers must be at least 18 years old and present a valid driver's license to the tour operator. Price is per mini Rhino. Only one person needs to book the tour. Pregnant women and guests with back/neck injuries may not participate on this excursion. Closed toe shoes are required.

ATV MAZATLAN BEACH ADVENTURE

Mazatlan, Mexico Tour Code: MZT 33

Enjoy a drive along the beach on a scenic and exciting ATV Adventure. This tour is perfect for both the beginner as well as the more advanced off-road rider. You'll travel approximately 30 minutes by bus or van to Delfin Beach where your semi-automatic ATV will be waiting. Upon arrival, your guide will provide instructions and mandatory safety gear.

Hop on your one person ATV and travel caravan style along the beach of the mighty Pacific Ocean. Your ride is for approximately 1 1/2 hours, as you enjoy miles of endless beach, palms trees and the gentle sea breeze. You'll return to a beachfront restaurant and have the opportunity to prepare your own quesadilla, made with handmade corn tortillas and enjoy refreshing soft drinks before returning to the ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 21 years of age with a valid driver's license and weigh less than 290 lbs. Due to rough terrain this tour is not for pregnant women, guests with heart or respiratory conditions, back or neck injuries. Participants should wear long shorts or pants and closed toe shoes. Bring a hat, sunglasses and sunscreen. Wear your swimsuit under your clothes and bring a towel if you wish to swim. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility. Activities may be reversed to accommodate participants. A complimentary snack is included in the tour.

NATURE EXPLORATION BY ATV & BOAT

Consider this nature exploration. You'll visit the Verde Camacho Ecological Center, a community run operation that helps educate and preserve the estuary and beaches of the region. Relax on the approximately one-hour ride from the pier.

Upon arrival, you'll take a boat ride to observe the estuary and its wildlife inhabitants, such as crocodiles and birds. At the end of the river, your ATV will be awaiting for your ride back along the beach while you learn more about the ecology of the area and the efforts locals are making to preserve it. Once back at camp, it's time to say goodbye to your new friends before your return to the ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 18 years of age and show a valid driver's license in order to drive the ATV. This tour is not for guests with back injuries or physical disabilities. Bring a hat and biodegradable sunscreen and bug repellent.

OLD MAZATLAN BY BIKE

Mazatlan, Mexico Tour Code: MZT 48

Join this easy, family oriented biking adventure. After your bike assignment and a safety briefing from your guide, you'll follow him along the small and quiet streets of old, downtown Mazatlan. Stop to visit the main cathedral and learn about this city's history while you ride through the historic center.

Continue along the oceanfront riding on the safe pedestrian/bike-only path. Get a close look at the sculptures and highlights before returning to the starting point, where you can either decide to stay in town on your own or head back to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, weigh less than 250 lbs. and be 50" in height or taller. Helmets are included in the tour price and are mandatory, as well as reflective light jackets. Participants must know how to ride a bike and have no history of back injuries or a heart condition. Pregnant women cannot participate.

HUANA COA CANOPY ADVENTURE

Mazatlan, Mexico Tour Code: MZT 19

Adrenaline will be pulsing through your veins after experiencing this canopy adventure! Situated approximately one hour outside of Mazatlan, the sprawling La Vinata Los Osuna plantation, where blue agave is grown and processed into tequila, is home to this exhilarating tour. Once you step off of your motorcoach, you'll be transported into a world that will take your breath away. The fun begins with the rush of an off-road experience in a classic Swiss Army Pinzgauer 6 x 6 vehicle delivering you from the valley floor into the foothills of the Sierra Madre mountain range that surround the plantation. From here, the action really begins. You'll get a thorough briefing on the techniques and safety measures used during your canopy adventure by a certified staff member who will provide you with equipment of the highest quality.

A series of 12 platforms with nine zip lines, a flex-walk bridge and nature trek await you. The course provides extraordinary views of the plantation's diverse flora and fauna while soaring above the valley floor. A rappel from the final platform located in an ancient Huanacaxtle tree will bring you safely back to earth among the vast rows of blue agave. Before returning to your ship, you'll have time to visit the Los Osuna tequila distillery. You'll see how this popular liquor is produced and be able to taste it as well. The return to your ship will be along Mazatlan's magnificent oceanfront boulevard passing by the Golden Zone, where you may choose to stay on your own for some shopping before returning to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 9 years of age, at least 4 feet tall and weigh no more than 250 lbs. Due to the nature of this tour, pregnant women or guests with a heart condition, knee pain or injury, spinal and/or neck problems or limited mobility should not participate. Please wear long pants, closed toe shoes and bring sunscreen. Signature on liability waiver is required. There are two nature treks during the course of the tour, participants must walk approximately 1/2-mile (735 yards) over some uneven terrain, climb steps up to platforms and rappel 40 feet 12 meters) down to the ground from the final platform.

SIERRA MADRE COUNTRY TOUR

Mazatlan, Mexico Tour Code: MZT_13

Rising behind Mazatlan is the Sierra Madre range of mountains, which separates the coastal area of Mexico from the interior. Rich in mineral wealth and extremely rugged, these mountains have become the subject of spectacular legends. Your exploration will take you from historic Mazatlan to the Durango Highway, stopping at a brickyard where adobe bricks are handmade and fired, much as they have been for several centuries. A short drive along the foothills of the Sierra Madre will take you into Concordia where you'll visit a 220-year old church and enjoy a refreshing drink at a typical small restaurant.

You'll continue to the village of Copala, once a thriving Spanish gold mining town founded in 1565, where you'll take a leisurely walk through the cobblestone streets. See Colonial houses, the jail and a spectacular church dating back to the early 18th century and enjoy a delightful lunch of Mexican food at a local restaurant. Visit a furniture factory and a potter's home who produces roof tiles, jars, flowerpots and dishes typical of this region. Back at Mazatlan's Golden Zone you'll have approximately 40 minutes of free time to browse and shop before the scenic drive back to your ship.

Note: Guests should be able to board bus without assistance. Walking is on both paved surfaces and rough terrain with inclines and multiple steps. Bring a hat, camera and comfortable walking shoes.

A TOPLESS BUS TOUR OF MAZATLAN

Mazatlan, Mexico Tour Code: MZT 46

Hop on the Fun Bus for an open-air, sky view of Mazatlan. This roofless double-decker bus offers you a convenient way to discover this destination. Stop at key points for pictures, slow down at others so you get more than a passing glimpse. Pass by some highlights such as the cliff divers who soar from their towering perch into a tiny dot of water, the Glorieta Germania lookout point, and the 19th century Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. The Cathedral is just one block from the public market in the heart of the downtown area. You'll see colorful buildings from the Golden Age of European architecture in the Historic District as well as the Golden Zone Shopping Center located in the hotel area. Here at the Golden Zone Shopping Center you'll have the opportunity to enjoy approximately 45 minutes of free time to browse and shop through the numerous craft and jewelry shops before returning back to your ship.

Note: Some sidewalks may be uneven and in bad condition. Wear comfortable walking shoes and sunscreen. Bring your camera and a hat.

Water, ice and limited beer and sodas will be provided on board, as well as a box lunch.

STONE ISLAND BEACH GETAWAY

A day of tranquility on the unspoiled Stone Island awaits you. Board a catamaran for a 25-minute cruise to Stone Island and pass by the Pacifico Brewery, the naval base and the fishing and shrimp fleet along the harbor. Upon arrival, you'll be transported via a typical cartload tractor that will take you to the soft waves, fine textured sand and natural landscape which makes Stone Island an isolated and relaxed environment.

For nearly three hours you're free to enjoy its unspoiled beaches that stretch for over 12 miles. For included optional activities, you can take a relaxing trek atop a carriage pulled by horse or ride a horse while admiring the abundant palm trees cultivated by ejido farmers or just enjoy a swim in the clear Pacific Ocean.

An island style lunch of fish, chicken, quesadillas served with refried beans, Mexican rice, salad and Mexican sauces, is served in a rustic restaurant. Beer, soft drinks, bottled water and domestic drinks are included.
