### ABU DHABI ORIENTATION AND HIGH TEA AT EMIRATES PALACE

Embrace the beauty, culture and traditions of the United Arab Emirates during an orientation tour of Abu Dhabi, and high tea at the spectacular Emirates Palace Hotel.

Enjoy an orientation drive through Abu Dhabi, the capital city of the UAE. Founded in 1761, Abu Dhabi is situated on a small peninsula surrounded by a cluster of islands. Along the way, you will pass Yas Marina, Ferrari World, Grand Mosque, Heritage Village and the famous Corniche, which offers spectacular views and photo opportunities of the city skyline, high-rise glass buildings and exquisite Emirates Palace Hotel.

Visit the Emirates Palace, the UAE's most prestigious hotel. Upon arrival, you'll take a walking tour of the grounds and be served high tea; the highlight of this tour.

### OASIS TOWN OF AL AIN

Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates Tour Code:

Experience scenic beauty during your full-day visit to picturesque Al Ain, the Garden City. Head to Al Ain, located in the eastern part of Abu Dhabi. Al Ain's lush terrain is dotted with abundant groundwater springs. In the past, this oasis town served as a vital stopover on the caravan trail between the United Arab Emirates and Sultanate of Oman.

Visit the Hilli Archaeological Park, where you'll find tombs from the 5,000-year-old Umm Al Nar Period. You'll also visit the Al Ain Museum, built around the turn of the 20th century. It is said that Sheikh Zayed, president of the UAE and ruler of Abu Dhabi, spent a part of his childhood there.

During your guided tour, you'll see the museum's ethnographical and archaeological sections. A highlight of the tour will be a walk through a truly enchanting oasis nestled amidst palm trees. Here, you will have an opportunity to see an excellent example of falaj, the ancient irrigation system.

Stop at the Camel Market, a unique regional market in which camels are traded daily. At one of the city's star

hotels, you'll be treated to a relaxing buffet lunch.

## ABU DHABI CITY TOUR

The history, architecture and culture of the United Arab Emirates are yours to discover during this scenic orientation tour of Abu Dhabi. Depart the pier for an orientation drive through Abu Dhabi, the capital city of the UAE. Founded in 1761, Abu Dhabi is situated on a small peninsula surrounded by a cluster of islands. You'll stop at Sheikh Zayed Mosque - also referred to as the Grand Mosque for an inside visit. This is the largest mosque in the United Arab Emirates and the eighth largest mosque in the world.

Drive to see the Heritage Village which houses a small museum and depicts the daily activities of the Arab community prior to the discovery of oil. Stop at the Manarat Saadiyat, an interactive guest experience center located on Saadiyat, this exciting artistic venue houses international exhibitions from around the world.

Your tour will conclude with a drive along the spectacular corniche and around the city of Abu Dhabi, known as the Manhattan of the Gulf due to a profusion of ultra-modern glazed skyscrapers, gleaming white mosques and elegant high-rise apartments overlooking the city's magnificent skyline.

## AL KHATIM DESERT BY OFF-ROAD VEHICLE

Explore Abu Dhabi on this exhilarating half-day, off-road desert adventure in the Al Khatim Desert. Start with a drive in your off-road vehicle through Abu Dhabi, and on to the Al Khatim Desert. You'll traverse the sand dunes that rise to imposing heights of up to 934 feet, the world's tallest. Along the way, stop for refreshments between the dunes, which are surrounded by the tranquil sands of Arabia.

Note: This tour involves travel over bumpy, uneven terrain. Not recommended for guests with back and/or neck

problems. Children must be at least four years old and accompanied by a parent to participate on this tour. Parents are advised to provide the age and height of the child so proper seats and safety belts can be arranged. There are no restrooms in the desert; a restroom stop will be made at a fuel station before entering and after exiting, the desert.

## Activity Levels

**ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.

**ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.

**ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
