## Tour Descriptions for Icy Strait Point, Alaska

### WHALE AND MARINE MAMMALS CRUISE

Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_14

You'll be escorted to the tender dock to board your whale boat for this 2 1/2 hour tour. Your journey will take you to Point Adolphus, one of Alaska's premier humpback whale watching destinations. You'll travel through waters that support a wide array of marine life including orca, Steller's sea lions, seal, Dall's porpoise and of course the magnificent humpback whale. Along the shore keep your eyes peeled for bald eagles in the evergreen treetops.

Your onboard naturalist will describe the biology and behavior of the diverse species that gather here every summer to indulge in the nutrient-rich waters, fueled by the long Alaska summer days. The whale population at Point Adolphus is so plentiful that the tour operator will refund you \$100 (\$50 per child) if a whale is not spotted on the trip.

### ATV EXPEDITION AND ZIPRIDER

Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_16

Meet your local guide at the Welcome Center and then board a bus for a guided tour through the Tlingit village of Hoonah en route to your departure site, high in the surrounding hills. After your safety briefing, board your 4x4 Kawasaki ATV and follow your local guide for a rugged ride through the forest with stops along the way for majestic and scenic photo opportunities.

Reboard your bus and ride to the ZipRider site. You'll take a leisurely downhill walk along a logging road to reach the launch site and get strapped into your harness. When it's your turn, you'll fly down the mountain at speeds up to 60 mph, soaring 300' above the tree tops, landing on the beach next to the Landing Zone restaurant.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and weigh a minimum of 90 lbs. and a maximum of 275 lbs. Guests must wear closed-toed shoes. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or those with back or neck problems.

### SCENIC MOUNTAIN ASCENT & WORLD'S LARGEST ZIPRIDER

Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_13

This is it, the world's largest zipline! Your local driver/guide will meet you in the Welcome Center check-in area to escort you to the bus for this 1-1/2 hour tour. You'll start with a guided tour through the village of Hoonah and up to the top of the mountain. After a short walk to the launching area, which is 1,300 feet high, you'll get strapped into a special harness seat.

When its your turn, you and five other guests will launch together and you're off, accelerating to as much as 60 mph as you pass 300' above the treetops. You'll see sweeping, breathtaking views of Port Frederick, Icy Strait and your cruise ship below. Your ZipRide concludes with a brake-activated landing on the beach by the Zip Stop where you can view and purchase a photo of your adventure. Your fellow cruisers will be at the Landing Zone restaurant next door to welcome you back to earth.

Note: Guests must wear closed-toed shoes. Participants must weigh a minimum of 90 lbs. and a maximum of 275 lbs. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or those with back or neck problems.

## ATV EXPEDITION

**Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_15**

Meet your local guide in the Welcome Center and board the bus for your ATV expedition. You'll enjoy a guided tour through the Tlingit village of Hoonah en route to the ATV departure site, located high in the surrounding hills. Upon arrival, attend an orientation and safety briefing. Then board your 4x4 Kawasaki ATV and follow your local guide for a rugged ride through the forest stopping for scenic views of the valley, mountains and ocean. Licensed drivers will have opportunity to switch driving responsibilities during the tour.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. This tour is not recommended for those with back or neck problems or pregnant women.

## FOREST & NATURE TRAM

**Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_02**

Your guide will meet you in the Fish House Excursion Lounge to escort you to the tram departure area. You'll discover first-hand the natural wonders of a wild southeast Alaskan rainforest on this 1 1/2 hour tour. Departing from Icy Strait Point, you and your local guide will ride a covered, wheeled tram approximately two miles through an old growth rainforest and along the shoreline where Chichagof Island meets the bountiful waters of Icy Straits.

Your guide will describe the ecological and cultural significance of the forest's unique plants and animals and how the island's Native Tlingit people are bound to its rich landscape. At the beachfront turn-around, you'll

have an option to explore the rocky beach on foot within view of an established bald eagle nest.

Note: We recommend you bring a raincoat.

## FOREST TRAM & TRIBAL DANCE

**Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_03**

Your guide will meet you in the Fish House Excursion Lounge to escort you to the tram departure area. A leisurely walk will take you to the tram for this 2 1/2 hour tour. You'll discover firsthand the natural wonders of the wild southeast Alaskan rainforest. Along with your local guide, you'll ride a covered wheeled tram approximately two miles through an old growth rainforest and along the shoreline where Chichagof Island meets the bountiful waters of Icy Strait.

Your guide will describe the ecological and cultural significance of the forest's unique plants and animals and how the island's Native Tlingit people are bound to its rich landscape. Upon your return to Icy Strait Point, you'll gather at the Heritage Center Native Theater for the Tribal Dance and Cultural Legends performance. Here, outstanding performers will entertain and educate you by sharing their culture and history through song, dance and storytelling.

Note: We recommend you bring a raincoat.

## WHALES & WILDLIFE

**Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_10**

You'll be met at the Fish House Excursion Lounge to begin the first portion of your combination tour. On a high speed catamaran, travel just 17 miles to Point Adolphus, one of Alaska's premier humpback feeding grounds and whale watching destinations. These nutrient-rich waters support a wide array of other marine life including orca, Steller's sea lion, and Dall's Porpoise to name a few. Head back to Icy Strait Point, board a bus and hear about the Tlingit village of Hoonah by your local guide while en route to the Spasski River.

Enjoy a beautiful drive through the interior forests and muskegs of Chichagof Island where you can watch for wildlife such as Sitka black-tailed deer, woodpeckers, bald eagles and coastal brown bear. Upon arrival at your destination, take a short walk on a boardwalk over the muskeg and arrive at three viewing platforms overlooking the river. Have your camera ready in case the bears happen to be out feeding.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. We recommend you wear warm layered clothing and a waterproof jacket.

## ICY STRAIT POINT KAYAKING

Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_06

Your guide will meet you at the Fish House Excursion Lounge to escort you to the staging area for an orientation and safety instruction. The protected waters of Port Frederick are yours to explore as you set off from the beach at Icy Strait Point in your two person wilderness sea kayak.

Led by your safety certified, local guide, you'll paddle along the Hoonah waterfront en route to quieter waters where bald eagles are often seen. Keep your eyes open and your spirit of adventure high throughout this 2 1/2 hour tour as humpback whales have been known to feed along the very same route you'll be paddling.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, weigh a minimum of 50 lbs. a maximum of 250 lbs. be at least 4'10" and no more than 6'4" in height.

## IN ALASKA'S WILDEST KITCHEN

Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_01

Your host will meet you at the Fish House Excursion Lounge for a short walk to Alaska's Wildest Kitchen. Here you'll experience a 1 1/2 hour hands-on tasting session hosted by an experienced Alaskan fisherwoman, wilderness chef and storyteller extraordinaire. Learn what sets Alaskan seafood apart, including local fishing, preserving and cooking techniques. Watch an expert filleting demonstration and grill your own sample of the catch of the day over a custom made alder-wood grill.

You'll enjoy a tasting menu which may include fresh and canned salmon dishes, grilled halibut and seasonal herbs and vegetables. One alcoholic beverage and printed recipes included in the tour. If you love food and are interested in hearing about a unique Alaska woman's way of life, this is the tour for you.

## TRIBAL DANCE & CULTURAL LEGENDS

Meet the Tlingit performers at the Fish House Excursion Lounge for a short walk to the Heritage Center Native Theater. After being seated in this beautiful, cedar building reminiscent of traditional Tlingit structures, you'll be treated to the Tribal Dance and Cultural Legends one hour performance showcasing the rich heritage of a people shaped by the wild lands and inland seas of southeast Alaska.

Wearing their colorful, traditional regalia, a group of proud Huna Tlingit performers share their history and culture through song, dance and storytelling. The show culminates in a lively traditional celebration and you're invited to join in! After the show you'll have an opportunity to have your photo taken with one of the performers.

Here, you'll be thoroughly entertained and educated through song, dance, and storytelling. You'll also be invited to dance with the Tlingit family on stage and have an opportunity to have your photo taken with one of the performers.

## SPASSKI RIVER VALLEY & WILDLIFE

Icy Strait Point, Alaska Tour Code: ICY\_08

Your guide will meet you in the Fish House Excursion Lounge for a brief safety talk before heading out to the bus for your 2 1/2 hour tour. Your journey out to the Spasski River is a tour in itself with your local guide narrating as you travel through the Tlingit village of Hoonah and through the forests and muskegs of Chichagof Island.

You'll want to keep an eye out for bald eagles, woodpeckers, Sitka black-tailed deer and the Alaska coastal bear. When you arrive at the river, your guide will lead you on "the trail of the bear," a boardwalk that follows in the footsteps of the island's largest inhabitant, as well as other wildlife that have used this area for thousands of years to access the bounty of the river and surrounding valley.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. You'll be in wilderness areas that are not fenced and the wildlife is not in captivity therefore, sightings cannot be guaranteed. We recommend that you wear comfortable

walking shoes.

## Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
