ACTIVITY LEVEL: STRENUOUS

You'll have a 45-minute drive to the **Congo Trail Private Reserve** where your adventure will begin. A platform located at ground level will mark the beginning of your experience. Industry-approved, ultra-safe harness equipment and a network of steel cables that connect eight trees in the forest will be your road to excitement while you learn the secrets of the dry forest. **Gliding from tree to tree**, you will have a birds-eye-view of the forest. The fauna is especially abundant here. Hundreds of different species of birds have been sighted, along with the howler monkey, many different snakes, coatis, and other mammals. At the end of the last cable, you will head back to earth and your ride back to your yacht.

Please note: This is a very active tour only recommended for guests who are in good physical condition. Wildlife sightings are not guaranteed.

Playas del Coco, Palo Verde National Park by Boat

ACTIVITY LEVEL: EASY

This tour will take you on a **boat ride** on the **Tempisque River**, bordering **Palo Verde National Park**, which flows into the Gulf of Nicoya, Guanacaste. **Birds are the biggest attraction** at Palo Verde; during the wet season the floodwaters of Tempisque River spread out creating extensive marshes that welcome migratory birds from North and South America. There is also a variety of mammals in the park, particularly during the dry season when peccaries, armadillos, jaguars, coatis, agoutis, deer, and monkeys are attracted to the river. You will admire a **Hacienda House**, built in the 19th century and recently refurbished. The views from the ample corridors of the savannas and sugar cane fields will take you back to the time of the great haciendas.

Please note: All animals in this National Park are wild animals. Please do not feed them. Wear light clothing, comfortable shoes, insect repellent, and sunblock, and bring a hat.
