ENCHANTING BUTCHART GARDENS

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_29

This tour offers the very best of Victoria, combining the city's unique highlights with a visit to the world-famous Butchart Gardens. Take in Chinatown and the Gates of Harmonious Interest, along with the Old Town and scenic Marine Drive. At Butchart Gardens, see how the Butchart family transformed a barren rock quarry into what is now one of the world's best-known horticultural attractions, covering more than 55 acres.

The gardens are a lush paradise of flowers, rare trees and winding paths, created more than 100 years ago. Enjoy the cascading fountains and footbridges connecting the many themed gardens, including the beautiful Sunken Garden, the Japanese Garden and the Rose Garden. A map will assist you with your self-guided tour.

Note: Walking time and distance is at guest's discretion, approximately 1 to 1.5 miles and up to 150 steps. Stairs, uneven terrain and steep inclines can be avoided by following routes marked accessible. You'll be at the gardens for about 1 hour and 45 minutes. BUTCHART GARDENS & VICTORIA HIGHLIGHTS

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_30

Enjoy the highlights of Victoria and a visit to the spectacular Butchart Gardens. Departing Ogden Point your guide will point out the highlights, which include the majestic Parliament Buildings, Empress Hotel, Royal British Columbia Museum, Beacon Hill Park, exclusive residential districts of the Uplands and Oak Bay with their manicured grounds and gardens, Bastion Square and Chinatown (the oldest in Canada) including the "Gates of Harmonious Interest".

At Butchart Gardens, see how the Butchart family transformed a barren rock quarry into what is now one of the world's best-known horticultural attractions, covering more than 55 acres. The gardens are a lush paradise of flowers, rare trees and winding paths. Created over 100 years ago, this once private garden is spectacular. Enjoy the cascading fountains and footbridges connecting you to the many themed gardens, including the beautiful Sunken Gardens, the Japanese Garden and the Rose Garden. A map will assist you with your self-guided tour.

Note: Walking time and distance is at guest's discretion, approximately 1 to 1.5 miles and up to 150 steps. Stairs, uneven terrain and steep inclines can be avoided by following routes marked accessible. Order of sights may vary. You'll be at the gardens for about 2 hours.

OCEAN WILDLIFE & ORCA EXPLORATION

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_09

Victoria is the gateway to Puget Sound, the Gulf Islands and San Juan Islands and is home to three resident pods of Orca Whales. The "J", "K", and "L" pods with approximately 90 whales in total, live in these waters, as well as a variety of other marine life. You'll have an opportunity to view Porpoise, Pacific Dolphins, Sea Otters, Stellar and California Sea Lions and more. This tour is designed to take you as up close and personal to the whales and marine life as possible, as they explore their natural feeding grounds along the shores of British Columbia's rugged coastline.

Your journey begins at the Ogden Point Cruise Terminal, where you'll be escorted to the whale watching vessel departure point. The large, deluxe catamaran is well equipped with restrooms, and offers comfortable covered, as well as open viewing decks. As you travel to the viewing location, be sure to enjoy the majesty of the coastlines and mountains surrounding you. This area is a playground for many of the world's wealthiest yacht owners, and multi-million dollar yachts can often be seen cruising through the waters.

Note: All efforts will be made to view the whales, but sightings cannot be guaranteed.

CRAIGDARROCH CASTLE & VICTORIA HIGHLIGHTS

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_05

Departing Ogden Point, your driver/guide will point out Mile Zero, the western end of the Trans Canada Highway and Beacon Hill Park en route to Craigdarroch Castle an outstanding landmark in a city steeped in heritage. The castle was built between 1887 and 1890 by Robert Dunsmuir and boasts a unique collection of residential stained and leaded glass, period furnishing, excellent wood paneling and carving. Enjoy your self-guided visit in this stately mansion with docents available to answer any questions you may have.

After your visit, rejoin your driver/guide passing Thunderbird Park and returning via Chinatown, welcomed by the Gates of Harmonious Interest. Continue to the inner harbor framed by some of Canada's most recognizable landmarks, the majestic Parliament Buildings aglow in 3,333 light bulbs and the ivy-covered Empress Hotel. At the inner harbor and shopping district, you'll be given some free time to take in the local sights and sounds prior to your return journey to the pier and your ship.

Note: Must have good mobility and be able to negotiate a gradual uphill walk to the castle and 87 steps to view all four floors of the castle. Referred to as a 'castle', the building is more a stately mansion with castellated features. Your visit of this unique stately home is self-guided with docents available to answer any questions you may have. Order of sights may vary.

VICTORIA HIGHLIGHTS

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_02

Victoria is one of the most picturesque cities in North America – it exudes old world charm and has a distinctively British flair. You'll discover the heart and soul of the "City of Gardens" on this tour and appreciate why so many visitors from around the world come each year to visit. Starting at Ogden Point you'll head into the residential neighborhoods, complete with manicured lawns, abundant flowers of all shapes and sizes, and million dollar views of the Strait of Juan de Fuca and the Olympic Mountain range.

Your tour will continue through the city's impressive Beacon Hill Park, complete with free flying peacocks and the world's tallest freestanding totem pole. After enjoying the sites of old town and Chinatown, you'll enter Victoria's Inner Harbor. This lively area is home to the Royal British Columbia Museum, numerous street performers, craft vendors, food stalls, Parliament Buildings and the world famous Fairmont Empress Hotel.

Note: Order of sights may vary. Ask your driver to let you off here and make your own way back to the ship, or continue on the motorcoach back to your ship.

BUTCHART GARDENS, PICNIC & VICTORIA HIGHLIGHTS

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_19

See Victoria's highlights aboard an eco-friendly coach, smell the fragrant flowers at Butchart Gardens and tantalize your taste buds with a bountiful picnic. While your knowledgeable guide points out some of Victoria's most interesting sights, you'll travel in comfort aboard an eco-friendly B100 coach fueled by biodiesel, made from recycled waste cooking oil collected from cruise ships visiting Victoria. With views of Beacon Hill Park as well as rolling landscapes and farmland en route, you'll arrive at Canada's famed National Historic Site - Butchart Gardens.

The gardens were transformed from a lifeless rock quarry to a horticultural masterpiece over 100 years ago. Stroll at your own pace through 55 acres of beautiful blooms and themed gardens. Upon arrival you'll be directed to your picnic site on the residence lawn and provided with your picnic basket prepared from fresh and locally grown organic produce. You may choose to enjoy your picnic on the lawn over a ground cover or at a picnic table. Guests sailing on Norwegian Pearl visiting on Saturdays July 25 thru September 5, 2015 will also be treated to a fireworks display.

On your return, enjoy a narrated sightseeing tour of Victoria's downtown area, including Chinatown, the historic Empress Hotel and the picturesque Parliament buildings. Your participation on this excursion will help support the local James Bay Community School, allowing vulnerable families the opportunity for their children to be able to partake in youth getaways, summer sports camps and more.

VICTORIA BY HORSE-DRAWN TROLLEY

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_12

The city and cruise port of Victoria are steeped in old world charm. With its manicured lawns and impressive displays of gardens and hanging baskets adorning the streets, on this one hour excursion you'll see why Victoria is nicknamed the "City of Gardens". At the cruise terminal you'll board your trolley, powered by two magnificent draught horses. Get cozy in your seat and feel free to wrap yourself in the provided blanket to ward off the sometimes cool evening air of this port city.

Your journey will take you past the gorgeous historical homes, located between the cruise terminal and the downtown inner harbor. Enjoy the lively narration of your guide as they "giddy up" and "whoa boy" this tour through town! You'll see the largest park in Victoria, as well as the famous Empress Hotel, and the British Columbia legislative buildings, commonly referred to as the Parliament buildings. Sit back and relax as you're carried by real horsepower back to the ship.

Note: This is an open-air vehicle and we recommend you bring a jacket. Guests will need to navigate two steps to board the trolley and due to safety concerns, wheel chairs, walkers, strollers and scooters must be left at the departure location.

BUG ZOO, MINIATURE WORLD & VICTORIA HIGHLIGHTS

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_37

This specially designed family experience includes a visit to the Victoria Bug Zoo, Miniature World with over 80 attractions and a narrated overview of Victoria's historic downtown and bustling inner harbour.

Aboard your motor coach, your narrated tour of Victoria's historic downtown you'll see views of Beacon Hill Park, Mile Zero, the Empress Hotel, Parliament Buildings, Victoria's Inner Harbour and Canada's oldest Chinatown. Stop for a visit at the Bug Zoo where an amazing world of insects and arachnids await you including giant walking sticks, bird-eating tarantulas, glow-in-the dark scorpions and Canada's largest ant farm. Knowledgeable bug guides will share a hands-on experience where you'll get up close to ith different insect species. Your visit ends with a complimentary healthy, safe and tasty bug lollipop!

After, a short walk will bring you to Miniature World, where both history and fantasy come together, many of which are interactive. The Great Canadian Railway, the world's smallest working sawmill, Circus World, Jack

& the Beanstalk, 1670 Olde London Towne and Space 2201, are just some of the exciting miniature displays, on this self-guided visit.

Note: You may end your tour with a transfer back to your ship or choose to stay downtown in Victoria's Inner Harbour and shopping district and make your own way back to the pier. Order of sights may vary.

SECRET GARDENS AND TEAHOUSE

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_38

The Abkhazi Garden is an exquisite heritage home and garden created by Prince and Princess Abkhazi in 1946. The garden is very discreet from the street, with only hints of what exists beyond the Hornbeam hedge. Here you'll find a garden that embraces a natural landscape that is unique to Victoria, with dramatic glaciated rocky slopes, magnificent native Garry Oaks and gorgeous vistas.

The garden flows around the rock, taking advantage of deeper pockets of soil for Conifers, Japanese Maples and Rhododendrons which over the last 50 years have grown to an impressive maturity. Abkhazi Gardens is listed as one of the top 100 gardens in the world. After your walk through the garden with your guide, come relax in the Tea House with a cup of tea and freshly baked scones.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. Wear good walking shoes. This tour is not offered on Norwegian Pearl's 2015 sailings.

VICTORIA BY BIKE

Victoria, British Columbia Tour Code: VIC_39

Victoria is known as the cycling capital of Canada and offers great cycling routes throughout the city. Join your guide on a leisurely circular route through quiet neighborhoods, tree-lined streets and see some of the highlights of this lovely city. At Ogden Point you'll be provided with a suitable bicycle, safety gear, and safety procedures to follow.

Your guide will highlight numerous points of interest on your ride and answer any questions that you may have. Stops will be made at Fisherman's Wharf, the downtown shopping district and Chinatown. On your return, you'll pass the majestic Parliament Buildings, The Empress Hotel and the Royal British Columbia Museum. You may ride back to the pier with your guide or enjoy more time here and return to the ship on your own.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. A reasonable level of fitness is required and biking experience is essential. Participants should be able to ride approximately 6 miles, about 1 hour and 45 minutes. Route has been chosen to avoid uphill climbs. Dress in warm layers and bring rain-gear. Informal rests and photo stops will be taken as needed. Equipment is provided. Order of sights may vary.

Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
