Panoramic Shanghai with Airport Drop Off - IU01

Drive from cruise pier and pass the Bund, extending between the Woosung River and Old town on Shanghai's waterfront, this area was formerly the financial hub of colonial Shanghai. The most identifiable structure is a 1,535 feet high Oriental Pearl TV Tower, the symbol of the 21st century Shanghai. Return to airport.
