Bilbao & Castro Urdiales - BV06

Begin with a tour of Bilbao's Old Quarter, the heart of the city where the narrow streets are lined with Renaissance, Baroque and Modernist buildings. Deboard the coach and begin a brief walking tour through the area. Your guide will point out the main sights including the Cathedral of Santiago, a Gothic Church of San Anton and the Plaza Nueva, an arcaded square. Afterwards, continue to Castro Urdiales, the town center with its characteristic houses with wooden rows of balconies. Then reboard the coach for the return trip to the pier.

Travel 45 minutes via coach to the Seven Streets section, the oldest part of Bilbao's Old Town, view landmarks such as the gothic Cathedral of Santiago, and then roam the alfresco Plaza Nueva. Bilbao & Tapas - BV09

Mountain Bike Tour At The Old Mine - BV64

From the mines to the residential area where local bourgeoisie lived in, the tour will take us back to the 19th century when Bizkaia was one of most powerful industrial areas in Europe. After a panoramic view to the old mining valley of Trapagarán the cable railway used by miners leads us to the top of La Reineta a hill 400 metres above sea level. The guided biking tour starts in La Arboleda Mountain, a beautiful natural area where the splendorous mining past is still visible.

Pedal back to the 19th century, when Bizkaia was one of the most powerful industrial areas in Europe. At La Arboleda Mountain, enjoy a panoramic view of the old mining valley. See the cable railway used by the miners, leading you to the top of La Reineta. Cycle past where the local bourgeoisie once lived. Plus visit Getxo to photograph Vizcaya Bridge, the world's oldest transporter bridge as well as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

- Cable railway: Follow the route used by miners to the top a hill 1,300-plus feet above sea level.

San Sebastian or Donostia, was made popular in 1886 by Queen Regent Maria Cristina and has been popular with Spanish aristocracy ever since. As you tour the modern part of the city, you will have the opportunity to see several buildings of architectural and historical interest including the Cathedral of Buen Pastor and the Town Hall. The Palace and Gardens of Miramar built by Queen Maria Cristina, the Theater and the luxury hotel named after the Queen will be all pointed out by your guide.

Discover Bilbao's nearby seaside towns with a guided bus tour of San Sebastian and scenic walking tour of French-bordered town, Hondarribia. View San Sebastian's well-manicured Palace and Gardens of Miramar and the Church of San Vicente, one of the surviving buildings of citywide fires. Gaze at the azure waters that fill La Concha Bay while standing atop Mount Igeldo. Admire the colorful facades lining the Hondarribia streets and stop in the luxurious fortress-turned-hotel, Parador.

Highlights:

- San Sebastian: See the Palace and Gardens of Miramar and the Church of San Vicente on a guided tour.
- Hondarribia: Wander seaside streets of this charming French-bordered town, filled with homes that flaunt vibrant balconies overlooking Chingoudy Bay.
- Parador: The former 10th-century Spanish castle was turned into an opulent hotel, complete with intimate stone-walled courtyard seating areas.
