Accessible Beaches - FC36

This excursion makes it easy for those with limited mobility to discover the war-era history of Normandy. You'll drive through the scenic Peninsula of Cotentin on your way to the American Cemetery in the village of Saint Laurent. Then, it's on to Omaha Beach, site of the legendary D-Day invasion. You'll also visit Sainte Mere Eglise, where a church damaged during the battle for Normandy, as American forces fought to dislodge Nazi snipers from the belfry.

Learn about the legendary World War II D-Day invasion on a guided tour of the Normandy beaches in the comfort of a wheelchair-accessible motor coach. Travel past the French coastline where land mines and other dangerous obstacles were once lodged during the war. View memorial statues and the Walls of the Missing at the Normandy American Cemetery. View somber Omaha Beach, entry point of the attack, and Sainte-Mère-Église chapel, with its memorial to fallen paratroopers.

Mont Saint Michel With Lunch - FC03

Mont Saint Michel is one of the greatest religious buildings in Europe with its abbey at the summit of a huge rock 250 ft above the sea. Completing this 30-minute walk, you will view the Abbey Church whose spire soars more than 500 feet. The Abbey is a masterpiece of Norman architecture. Inside you'll discover the ways of the monks by visiting their famous dining hall, and the beautiful gothic cloister, which appears to be suspended between sky and sea. After the guided portion of the tour, you will have free time in the charming village of Mont Saint Michel to explore the twisted passageways, old houses, and shops.

Explore one of France's most recognizable landmarks on a guided tour of the Mont Saint Michel abbey before enjoying lunch and free time to roam. Travel on foot to the elevated Norman Benedictine monastery, where you can admire Romanesque architecture and the churches soaring spires. Savor a tasty French meal in the famous dining hall where fervent monks gather. Wander around the medieval town independently, where you can meander through winding streets and souvenir shop.

Normandy Gardens - FC15

On this tour, you'll experience two very different castles in the French countryside. First, stroll the endless botanical gardens at Vauville Castle. This modern wonder was created in 1947 and is home to more than 500 varieties of plants and flowers native to the southern hemisphere. Then, enjoy an exterior visit of the 16th-century Nacqueville Castle. Set in an old English park, its lavish gardens are famous for colorful rhododendrons, azaleas, and arum lilies that run along the riverside. Guests must be able to walk approximately 1.5 miles over uneven surfaces and 40/50 steps.

Delight in Cherbourg's enthralling heritage and natural splendors as you tour two picturesque Normand castles and enjoy roaming around their lush botanical gardens. Meander around the private subtropical grounds of Vauville Castle, where you can view 900 species of plants from the Southern Hemisphere, including eucalyptus and bamboo, while relishing spectacular Atlantic Ocean vistas. Admire the romantic topiaries and 19th-century fairytale charm of Nacqueville Castle, with its colorful azaleas, giant gunnera, and picturesque riverfront park.

The Saire Valley - FC02

Drive along the coastline to the port of Barfleur, where the granite homes of lobster fishermen line the waterfront.

Continue to Saint Vaast la Hougue – a fishing port, yachting harbor, oyster grounds, and resort town all in one postcard-perfect setting. Walk to the Sailors Chapel and see the ancient fort tower that still watches over the bay. Head further into the valley to explore a landscape of green hills, pastoral farmland, and majestic waterfalls. Tour involves approximately 0.5 miles over cobblestone and even surfaces with steps. The drive to/from Cherbourg is approximately 40 minutes each way. Time permitting; guests will have approximately 1 hour at leisure. Tour sequence may vary.

Discover the Saire Valley's historical grandeurs as you travel from Cherbourg to the harbor-front town of Saint Vaast la Hougue to explore its notable landmarks. Admire picturesque countryside as you journey via motor coach through the Val de Saire region on the Cotentin Peninsula. Visit quaint Saint Vaast la Hougue, a fishing village known for its large marina, 17th-century fortified towers, and renowned oyster production. Wander at your leisure or visit the 12-century sailors' chapel.

- Val de Saire: Enjoy panoramic countryside vistas while traveling by coach through the Saire River valley on the Cotentin Peninsula.
