Explore in Dazaifu - FV14

1300 years ago, "Dazaifu", the large public office which governed the whole of Kyushu, was established. This tour highlights on Dazaifu, visiting Dazaifu Tenman Shrine and Kyushu National Museum to learn and enjoy the history and art.

Discover Japan's Dazaifu Tenman-gu Shrine and Kyushu National Museum on a guided 4-hour tour. Enjoy an approximately 1-hour drive to Dazaifu Tenman-gu Shrine, dedicated to the exiled scholar Sugawara Michizane, who was banished from Kyoto to Dazaifu in 901 A.D. He is venerated as the God of Learning. Students still pray to him for academic success. Visit Kyushu National Museum, Japan's newest National Museum, with the historical exchange between Asian countries and Japan on exhibit.

Highlights:

- Dazaifu Tenman-gu Shrine: Built to appease the spirit of 9th century scholar Sugawara after various natural disasters followed his death.
- Kyushu National Museum: See exhibits showcasing the historical exchange between Asian countries and Japan before returning to your ship.

Full Day in Karatsu - FV15

Karatsu, a part of Genkai Quasi-National Park, has many scenic spots and is also noted for Karatsu-yaki pottery, and has around 60 pottery studios in the city. Included in this full day tour, Karatsu Castle, Hikiyama Display Hall, Karatsu Shrine, and kiln are located nearby in this small cozy city.

Discover Japan's 17th century Karatsu Castle on a 6-hours and 30-minutes history and culture tour. A one hour drive takes you to historic Karatsu Castle. Built by Lord Terashima in 1608, the castle is now a public museum with archeological and pottery displays. See authentic Hikiyama -floats pulled on four-wheeled carts during the Karatsu Kunichi Festival that began in the 1700's. Lunch at a local restaurant or hotel banquet room before visiting a pottery kiln.

Highlights:

- Karatsu Castle: Visit Lord Terashima's historic 43-meters-high castle, with hill top views of Karatsu city and Matshuura Bay.
- Hikiyama Exhibition Hall: Witness the variety of 14 floats created for the 17th century Karatsu Kunichi Festival celebrated every November.
- Kiln Visit: See local potters at work turning out Karatsu-yaki, primitive but well represented pottery styled after Korean designs.

Full Day in Kokura with Bullet Train Ride - FV28

This is full day tour including traditional sites, Kokura Castle and local market, and highlight of this tour is to take a bullet train. You will enjoy 20 min ride from Kokura to Hakata station.

Discover Japan's Kokura Castle and Tanga Ichiba market on a 7-hours and 45-minutes culture tour. An approximately 1.5-hour drive takes you to historic Kokura Castle, built by Lord Hosokawa Tadaoki in 1608 but later destroyed in 1868's Meiji Restoration. In 1959 a four-story, five-layer donjon and turrets were reconstructed. Katsuyama Park and a number of modern municipal and cultural offices now share the grounds. Lunch at a local restaurant before visiting Tanga Ichiba Market.

Highlights:

- Kokura Castle: Visit Lord Hosokawa Tadaoki's historic castle that once had an imposing donjon, 148 turrets and 48 gates.
- Tanga Ichiba Market: Experience approximately 120 shops at the 180-meter long arcade offering fresh fish, meats, fruits and groceries.
- Bullet Train: Following your market visit, board the Shinkansen to Hakata Station for approximately 20-minutes high-speed transfer to Hakata Port.

Highlights of Fukuoka Half Day - FV13

The culture, traditions and history of the port that was a gateway to mainland Asia are revealed through its leading monuments and landmarks. The tour includes stops at the Fukuoka Tower, for panoramic views from the observation desk; the classic Japanese garden in Ohori Park; and the Kushida Shrine, the city's oldest shrine, which contains an elaborately decorated wooden float used in an annual festival that dates back 700 years.

Discover Japan's Fukuoka Tower, Ohori Park and Kushida Shrine on a sightseeing 4-hour tour. Experience the 360-degree panoramic view of Fukuoka city from the Fukuoka Tower's observation deck 123 meters high with a mirror-covered cross-section called a "Mirror Sail." Explore Ohori Park with a stroll past its winding stream, Karesansui (rock garden) and Sukiya-style teahouse. Visit the 8th century Kushida Shrine and see the Kazari Yamagase (wooden float) used in the Hakata Gion Festival.

Highlights:

- Fukuoka Tower: A triangular shaped cross-section covered in 8,000 mirrors enhances the view from an observation deck 123 meters high.
- Japanese Garden - Ohori Park: Explore gardens, hills, woods and ponds, landscaped to express natural beauty in traditional Japanese style.
- Kushida Shrine: Pass the giant torii-style gate and see the shrine's ginkgo tree, designated a natural treasure, and Kazari Yamagase.
