Barcelona & Montserrat with Lunch - BR13

Indulge yourself in the beauty, history, and art of Barcelona and Montserrat. In Barcelona, you'll see stunning Gothic-Modernist architectural masterpieces, including the Sagrada Familia Cathedral, the Casa Milà, and the Casa Batlló, designed by Catalan architect Antoni Gaudí. Upon reaching Diagonal Avenue, you'll make your way up to the Montserrat Mountains, where you'll discover the ancient Benedictine Monastery, dating back to the 11th Century.
