A Wildlife Adventure Tour - BE61

Take a motor-launch ride up the Old Belize River and look for crocodiles, iguanas, and monkeys and take in the beautifully lush tropical foliage on this varied waterway. Altun Ha Mayan Site and River Wallace - BEE2

Hold on to your hats as you enjoy an exhilarating boat ride along the city's scenic coast.
