Cadiz City Sights - CD10

Jutting from Bay of Cadiz & surrounded by water, Cadiz claims to be Europe's oldest city. Legend names Hercules as its founder, although history credits Phoenicians. Guide will walk with you thru old town. Tour takes you to highlights that are difficult to find on your own, city street grid was designed to confuse pirates. You'll see Plaza de Espana, Town Hall, Plaza de San Juan de Dios, Cathedral & rampart walls of city. Free time is given. Note: Guests walk approx 4 kms over even surfaces with 15 - 25 steps. Not recommended for walkers or wheelchairs. Shorts or bare shoulders are not permitted in Cathedral. Please dress conservatively.

See highlights of Europe's oldest city too difficult to find on your own. Did you know Cadiz's street grid was designed to confuse pirates? Stroll the 15th-century Plaza de San Juan de Dios, constructed on lands reclaimed from the sea. See the interior of Cadiz Cathedral, with styles ranging from 13th-century Baroque to 19th-century neoclassical, and view the rampart walls of this once-fortified city. Then spend some free time enjoying a refreshment at a local cafe.

In sea paddling activity on Zahara Lake, you will see many areas along route that can only be appreciated from a small boat or canoe. This is a fun adventure for experienced & novices in a safe, stable one or two-seater open boat. Upon arrival at the launch site, receive safety gear & basic paddling techniques.
