Travel through scenic Prince Edward Island on a half-day tour, visiting two historic lighthouses and enjoying a wine tasting at an award-winning winery. Your first stop is Point Prim Lighthouse, standing at nearly 60 feet. Built in 1846, it is the island's oldest lighthouse. Next is the Wood Islands Lighthouse, measuring nearly 50 feet high. This lighthouse began operations in 1876 to aid in marine traffic in the Northumberland Strait and fishing boats in and around Wood Island. It has an attached two-story dwelling, where the keeper resides. Lighthouses were very important for trade and commerce, especially shipbuilding, as it was the first mode of transportation for early settlers. Many lighthouses built before 1873 are octagon in shape and were constructed when area timber was in abundant supply. Those built afterward are square-tapered. Each lighthouse had its individual day markings and distinguished flash patterns.

Your last stop is at Rossignol Estate Winery for unlimited taste testing paired with Prince Edward Island cheese. The winery has a 45,000-bottle capacity and produces a variety of premium fruit and table wines made from local produce. Be sure to try their 2013 Gold Medal Winners: Cassis, Isle Saint-John White and Wild Blueberry.
