Fishing at Gatun Lake - CO79

Spend a scenic day 'catch and release' fishing against a backdrop of lush jungle foliage and verdant hilltops at Gatun Lake. Nestled in the valley of the Chagres River, Gatun Lake was created in the early 20th century and forms a major part of the Panama Canal. Upon arriving at the lake, your captain will take you to the best fishing areas where you'll search for Tarpon, Snook, Oscar, Peacock Bass and the abundant Sargent. License fees, bait and tackle are included in the tour cost. Tour involves minimal walking. Tour is suitable for guests with limited mobility, provided they can embark/debark the fishing boat with minimal assistance.

Catch and release a variety of fish at Gatun Lake, one of the best spots in Panama. The renowned lake was once a vast jungle teeming with an overwhelming abundance of wildlife prior to the construction of the Panama Canal. Upon arriving at Lake Gatun, your captain will find spots to fish Tarpon, Snook, Oscar and Peacock Bass. Sargent fish are the most common since they were introduced to Gatun Lake to control algae.

Panama City Tour - CO52

There is only one place in the world that you can arrive by the Atlantic Ocean and in 1-hour be on the Pacific side, Panama. Your tour begins when you board your bus for a 1-hour narrated drive to Panama City. A mix of modern and colonial architecture, Panama City is filled with history. There is approximately .5 to 1 mile of walking on this tour. Women 6 months pregnant or over may not participate.

Explore the layered history of Panama, the first European city established on the Pacific Coast of the Americas. Visit Panama Viejo, the old city founded by Spain in 1519. See the ruins of nearly 100 civic and religious buildings, one of which served as headquarters for conquistador Francisco Pizarro during his conquest of the Incan Empire. The old city was destroyed by the English pirate Henry Morgan in the late 1600s, and rebuilt a few years later on a more defensible peninsula, becoming the second Panama City.

It is in the “newer” city, called Casco Antiguo, where you’ll find a variety of structures — around 800 buildings representing an architectural mix of colonial, French, Caribbean, republican, art deco and more. Designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site, most of the city’s main monuments are in this area, including the National Theater, Salón Bolivar and Plaza de Francia. The modern, cosmopolitan areas of Panama City add a third layer to this historically rich city. The nearby skyscrapers and casinos are a reminder that Panama City owes much of its cosmopolitan and international flavor to the Panama Canal, the giant ditch that brings the world to its isthmus. Tour includes snack and bottled water.

Highlights:

- Six-hour tour: Explore the ruins of Panama Viejo, visit the colonial and baroque buildings in the Casco Antiguo.
- UNESCO World Heritage Site: Casco Antiguo’s buildings represent an architectural mix of colonial, French, Caribbean, republican and art deco.
- Modern Panama City: The sleek skyscrapers and casinos are a sharp contrast to the first two versions of the city.
