Castles of North Zealand - CP73

Upon arrival in Helsingør, see the imposing Kronborg Castle (inside visit), which was the setting of "Hamlet". After Kronborg, you will drive through a hilly landscape to Hillerød and the castle of Frederiksborg, en route passing the Fredensborg Palace (photo stop), the spring and autumn residence of the Royal Danish Family. Frederiksborg Castle (inside visit), the beautifully situated renaissance building which – like many others - was built by orders of King Christian IV. Today, the castle is the home of the Museum of National History.

Discover Copenhagen's distinguished royal heritage as you tour three distinct castles on the island of Zealand, viewing magnificent architecture, regal gardens, and enthralling museum exhibits. Visit 15th-century Kronborg Castle, which was the setting for William Shakespeare's tragedy Hamlet. Admire stunning baroque gardens at Fredensborg Palace, the spring and autumn residence of the Danish royal family. Behold stately Frederiksborg, the largest Renaissance castle in Scandinavia, where you can roam its Palace Church and natural history museum.

Castles of North Zealand - CP08

Spend a full day exploring some of Denmark's most notable royal landmarks and picturesque sights. Your sightseeing journey begins with a scenic drive along the coast of North Zealand, past fashionable mansions and charming villages, to arrive at Kronborg Castle. Built in the late 16th century, this architectural wonder served as the inspiration for "Elsinore" in Shakespeare's acclaimed play, "Hamlet". Next, you'll visit the spectacular Frederiksborg Castle, which houses the Museum of National History and a priceless collection of paintings, porcelain treasures, and tapestries. Your experience culminates with a delicious lunch near Fredensborg Palace, the queen's official residence.

Explore the countryside north of Copenhagen- the setting for Hamlet and home to several royal residences. Your drive through North Zealand takes you along a coastal road dotted with picturesque villages to Kronborg Castle, where Shakespeare based his powerful masterpiece about a Danish prince. You'll enjoy lunch at a lovely inn in North Zealand. On this day-long tour, you'll also visit the magnificent Renaissance Frederiksborg Castle, which houses the Museum of National History.

Highlights:

- Kronborg Castle: See "Elsinore" - the imposing structure renowned in Shakespeare's Hamlet. The castle was built in the late 1500's.
- Fredensborg Palace: This is the queen's official residence, a baroque style palace that opened in 1722.
- Frederiksborg Castle: Discover Danish history through the priceless paintings, porcelain, tapestries and furniture at this picturesque castle.

Charming Copenhagen - Walk & Cruise - CP13

Explore Copenhagen on foot and then set off down the city's ancient canals for an entirely different viewpoint. Your day begins with a walking tour along the waterfront, past the Queen's Palace and gardens and into the seafaring history of Nyhavn. Then, it's time to cruise Copenhagen's ancient canals. Old world meets new, as you motor past important sites, including Our Saviour's Church and the Black Diamond, the modern wing of the Royal Library. Guests must be able to walk approximately 2 miles (2.5 hours) over cobblestone streets and even surfaces. Low heeled, comfortable walking shoes and comfortable, loose clothing are recommended.

Experience Copenhagen's charms and history on a walking tour and boat ride to capture the essence of the city that has been Denmark's capital since 1417. Your journey begins at the Hans Christian Andersen-inspired Little Mermaid, winds past the Queen's Palace, Amalienborg and on to the canals of Nyhavn, the old sailor's quarter now a fashionable center, where you'll pause for a drink. Then hop aboard our boat for a leisurely cruise through picturesque Christianshavn.

Highlights:

- The Little Mermaid: Get a photo at the 100-year-old sculpture gifted to the city by Carlsberg brewer Carl Jacobsen.
- Church of Our Saviour: The baroque church in Christianshavn has a serpentine spire with a 400-step climb to the top.
- Odd Fellow Palace: Enjoy refreshments at this beautiful manor that houses a concert hall.

City Sightseeing with Dragor Village - CP14

Explore the busy streets of Copenhagen and then discover the quiet farming village of Dragor. You'll see the best of the city, including Tivoli Gardens and Amalienborg Palace, home of the Royal Family. A short drive to the island of Amager takes you to the Village of Dragor, first settled by farmers in the 16th century. Strolling the cobblestone streets of this sleepy little village transports you to the simpler times of Denmark long ago. Guests must be able to walk approximately 0.5 mile over even and cobblestones surfaces with 10 to 15 steps. Depending on traffic and how crowded the attractions are, the guide may alter the order of the tour.

See the significant sights of Copenhagen and then discover the historic seaside village of Dragør. The ideal introduction to Denmark's capital takes you by Town Hall Square and the amusement-ride and flower-filled Tivoli Gardens. Stop for a photo at Christiansborg Castle, parliament's home, and at Amalievehen, the beautiful seafront park, before you head to the end of Amager island and Dragør, a quaint town settled by the Dutch in the early 16th Century.

Highlights:

- Tivoli Gardens: One of the world's oldest amusement parks dates from 1843 and overflows with fun rides and greenery.
- Amaliehaven: Explore this little oasis with its fountain and flowers close to the harbor and the queen's residence – Amalienborg Palace.
- Dragør: See charming yellow painted homes and stop for coffee in this town that once produced food for Danish royalty.

Copenhagen By Bicycle - CP01

If you want to see Copenhagen like a local, travel its streets like a local. Hop on a bike and go exploring. Pedal along the harbor and make your way to Amalienborg Palace. Continue to the old sailors' quarter that's now a fashionable promenade of shops and cafes. Cross the King's New Square to ride along the beautiful King's Garden, before biking through Nyboder, a neighborhood of yellow-painted homes reserved for Navy families. Guests must be able to cycle approximately 4.5 miles (2.5 hours) on this tour. Guests should be comfortable using hand brakes and be confident on a bicycle. Participants must be at least 60 inches (150 cm) in height.

Experience the sights and delights of Copenhagen by bike, the most popular mode of transportation among locals. The 4.5 mile tour winds from the harbor to the city's symbolic Little Mermaid, then on to the elegant Amalie Garden and Queen's Palace, Amalienborg. Next are the canals of Nyhavn, the old sailor's quarter, now a popular center with restaurants and bars, the lush King's Garden, the 17th Century Rosenborg Castle and the painted houses of Nyboder.

Highlights:

- Nyhavn: Enjoy the old port's fashionable promenade with homes of famous residents such as Hans Christian Andersen.
- Rosenborg Castle: The Renaissance palace houses a museum containing the coronation throne, tapestries and crown jewels.
- Nyboder: See the colorful, historic row houses commissioned for naval families five centuries ago by King Christian IV.
